Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The Pooled Fund is now in active implementation. All partners have disbursed at least the first advance and over the past six months a number of the activities agreed in the 2016 Action Plan have either been completed or are under implementation or preparation (bidding documents, etc). The project team has considerable experience from managing a previous pooled fund and the procurement and financial management functions are working well. Some of the main activities implemented to date are:

(i) Acquisitions of hygiene kits as part of the Ebola recovery action plan; (ii) the re-launch of the EGRA pilot with the training of teachers and acquisitions of pedagogical materials; (iii) assessment of learning in CE2, (iii) acquisition of pedagogical materials for the pre-school level; and (iv) transfer of grants to the deconcentrated levels of the ministry of pre-university education to finance agreed activities.

School construction has not yet been launched, but preparations are sufficiently advanced that the procurement can be launched shortly. A mission to screen construction sites for social, technical and safeguards issues will be carried out in June.

Some of the more reform-oriented activities will take a little longer to launch, as not all the Technical Assistance is in place yet, including the consultant to support the preparation and implementation of a Plan for the transfer of competencies from the Project Coordination Unit to the relevant ministry departments.

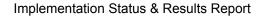
A joint implementation support mission took place in May 2016 working with the project team to review progress, address implementation bottlenecks, support the preparation of school construction and human resources reform, and follow up on legal covenants and results. The mission also participated in the joint sector review.

Disbursements stand at 14% on average for the two trust funds, up from 12% in December.

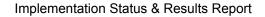


