Project Development Objective (from Project Appraisal Document) The objective of the project is to support the Government of Lao PDR in improving pre-primary and primary education quality.

This will be done by: (i) providing additional funding at school, district and provincial levels, as well as strengtheningoverall capacity to manage these resources to achieve minimum education quality standards and (ii) enhancing the teaching and learning environment in schools through improved teaching practices, instructional resources and analytical products to support early grade literacy.




Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The project launch was satisfactory with attendance of the government concerned ministries, representatives from project provinces, districts and all interested development partners. The launch was co-chaired by the Deputy Prime Minister and Ministers of MoES, Vice Minister in charge, Coordinating Agency (UNICEF and DFAT) and the World Bank.

Implementation of the component 1 - Strengthening school based management (SBM) has continued to progress ahead. The area of SBM is being strongly supported by various development partners in the country. All development partners shared the needs of close collaboration and coordination among various projects to ensure that all projects are well coordinated by the MoES and moving toward a harmonized and consistent approach of concept, implementation process, including a single national training plan and regular support to schools and local levels. Agreement has been reached, in principles among the development partners (DP) and the government to share responsibilities in working together to support the MoES. Each DP will be leading a specific area of SBM, in supporting the technical department in charge to coordinate implementation of related activities, in consultation with all DPs. Detailed arrangement will require further discussion with all partners.

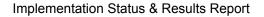








