- The Co-operative Republic of Guyana has received a loan from the from the Inter-American Development Bank toward the cost of the Road Network Upgrade and
 Expansion Program and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this to payments under the Contract for Rehabilitation of East Bank Berbice Main Road, Stanleytown
 to Everton, Region 6
- 2. The Ministry of Public Infrastructure now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for the Rehabilitation of the roadway from Stanleytown to Everton. It entails the construction and expansion of culverts and bridges; construction of sidewalks, medians, parking lanes, bicycle lanes and road shoulders; installation of road safety elements such as crossings, bus stops, road marking, concrete paved sidewalk, signs and road lighting; and relocation of public utilities. The delivery/construction period is Twelve Months.
- Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) proceduresspecified in

 Development Bank's Policies for the Procurement of Goods and Worksfinanced by the Inter-American Development Bank, and is open to all bidders from Eligible SourceCountries as defined in the Bidding Documents.
- 4. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from Ministry of Public Infrastructure Works Services Group and inspect the Bidding Documents at Address Nr.1 given below, between Monday to Thursday from 09:00 and 15:00 hours, and on Friday between 09:00 to 14:00 hours, Guyana Time. These Bidding Documents are available from Monday, March 14, 2016.
- 5. Qualifications requirements include: Average annual construction turnover of "US\$2,000,000, must substantially completed one civil engineering project with a value of at least US\$2,000,000 and demonstrate access to liquid assets and/or credit facilities from a Financial Institution of a minimum of US\$1.5 Million. Further details on qualifications requirements are outlined in the Evaluation Criteria of the Bidding documents. A margin of preference for national contractors/JVCAs shall not be applied.
- 6. A complete set of Bidding Documents in English may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written application to the address Nr. 1 below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of GY\$10,000. The method of payment will be by Cash, Bank Draft or Manager's Cheque in favour of the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Public Infrastructure. The Bidding Documents can be uplifted at the Works Services Group.
- Bids must be delivered to the Address 2 below before 09:00hrs on April 26, 2016. Electronicsubmission of bids is not permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened physically in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend in person at the Address Nr. 2 below after 09:00hrs on April 26, 2016.
- 8. All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security of US\$80,000.
