The Government of Guyana has received a loan from the Inter-American Development Bank (LO-2741/BL-GY: Road Network Upgrade and Expansion Program) toward the cost of the Sheriff Street - Mandela Avenue Roadway Enhancement project. The Government of Guyana intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to payments under the contract for Enhancement to the Sheriff Street - Mandela Avenue Roadway (approximately 7km).

The Ministry of Public Works now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the following works: The scope of works for the Sheriff to Mandela road corridor includes Asphaltic Pavement, road safety, upgrade traffic intersection signals at each of the major road junctions, traffic and drainage improvement works. There will also be structural works to bridges, culverts and other supporting infrastructure. Pavement works will include the construction of a two-lane roadway with a median portioning the two lanes along Sheriff Street. The first section of Mandela Avenue will involve the expansion of the roadway from a two lane to a four lane with a median in the center, while the second section would be three lanes. The total distance of roadway to be rehabilitated / constructed is 7km and would involve road widening, reconstruction of failed sections and asphalt overlay.

The delivery/construction period is *thirty two (32) months*. Bids must be submitted with the Bid Security to the tune of *US\$200,000*.

Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding procedures specified in the Inter-American Development Bank's Policies for the Procurement of Works and Goods Financed by the Inter-American Development Bank, G/N-2349-9 (March 2011), and is open to bidders from all countries as defined in the guidelines.

Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from and inspect the bidding document at the Ministry of Public Works (address (1) below) from Monday to Thursday between 0900 and 1600 hours, and on Friday between 0900 to 1500 hours, from Tuesday, May 12, 2015 to Tuesday, July 7, 2015.

A complete set of the electronic bidding document in English may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written Application to the address (1) below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of Ten Thousand Guyana Dollars (GY\$10,000.00) or Fifty United States Dollars (US\$50.00). Bidders are required to indicate an e-mail address in their application, where any changes to the bidding document can be sent to and received by bidders. The method of payment will be cash or bank draft, payable to the Ministry of Public Works, Guyana.

Electronic submission of bids will not be permitted.

Bids must be delivered to the address (2) below by Tuesday, July 7, 2015 at 09:00hrs. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security as stated above. Late bids will not be considered.
