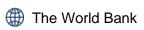

Implementation Status Overview

This ISR covers the main findings, results, and issues and actions of a supervision mission to Moldova from May 6-10, 2013.

The project is at the end of its second year of implementation. Current disbursement is US\$4.2 million from IDA funds and US\$1.8 million from the Dutch TF, for a total of US\$6.0 million. All activities funded by the Dutch TF were fully completed and TF has been fully disbursed and closed.

The most important milestones achieved by the project to date are completion of M-Cloud Phase 1 and the launch of the first four e-Services. There was a very good uptake of e-



Services in Moldova, the most notable is Criminal Records showing that 90% of beneficiaries chose to obtain this service from the government electronically. This translates into 82,371 citizens of Moldova who did not have to spend 4-8 hours in line in addition to commuting to Chisinau and regional centers. Another area of success is the uptake of open government, the government has published to date 627 datasets. These datasets were used by NGOs and Private Sector to develop 15 free standing applications for citizens; among them applications for monitoring government budget, mapping planned road rehabilitation, statistics on 1529 schools, mapping of polluted regions, population statistics. Moldova joined OGP partnership and also developed an open government data catalog.

The team would like to note significant improvement in project management of the eGC. The alignment of procurement, financial, project management, and results data agreed upon during the last visit has been completed and currently serves as a platform for more effective project monitoring. It was observed that implementation of M-Cloud Phase 2 is behind schedule due to delays in preparation of the Cloud Demand Assessment and the M-Cloud PPP Feasibility Study. There have also been constraints in internal capacity at eGC as well as in the capacity of line ministries to undertake business process re-engineering, thus delaying planning of the next set of e-Services to be launched in 2014.

Key priorities for the next six month are (i) implementation of the second round of e-Services (e-Visa, electronic fiscal invoices, integrated hospital management system, integrated primary healthcare system, e-administration, document management system, e-Appointment, e-Certificates and e-Reporting); (ii) interoperability framework; and (iii) digitization of archives.

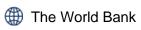

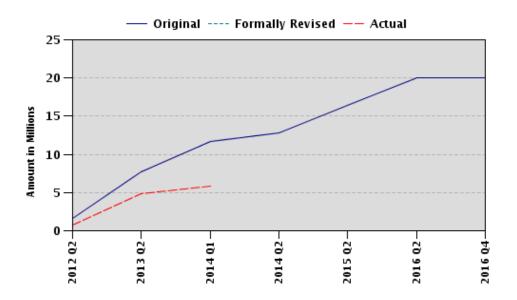

Key Decisions Regarding Implementation

The Government and the World Bank team agreed to the following actions:

- 1. Agreement was reached to add e-Procurement system as a service under Component 2: Shared infrastructure and e-Services.
- 2. The implementation of activities (m-Cloud Phase I) funded by the Dutch TF has been completed. The WB Team informed the government of the closure of the TF. Significant progress has been achieved under the PPIAF funded study for M-Cloud Phase II. Study completion is anticipated for November-December, 2013 which will allow the team to move forward with the implementation of M-Cloud Phase II.
- 3. In order to allow efficient utilization of funds within the framework of the Project Development Objective the teams discussed the potential need for re-structuring to be undertaken during the Mid-Term review. The three subcomponents under consideration for r-structuring are 1.1.2 (e-Leaders, Civil Servants and IT Specialists Training Program), 1.2.2 (Develop the Legal, Regulatory, and Technical Frameworks), and 2.2.2 (Enabling Services).
