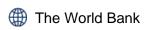

Implementation Status Overview

This ISR covers the main findings, results, and issues and actions of a supervision mission to Moldova from September 23-28, 2013.

The project is at the end of its second year of implementation. Current disbursement is US\$4.9 million from IDA funds and US\$1.8 million from the Dutch TF, for a total of US\$6.0 million. All activities funded by the Dutch TF were fully completed and TF has been fully disbursed and closed.

The most important milestones achieved by the project to date are the completion of M-Cloud Phase 1 and the launch of four initial e-Services. The eGC also successfully launched



work under the 2012-2013 e-Services portfolio including e-Visa, e-Fiscal Invoice and front end automation for the real estate registry. The eGC also launched the development and digitization of a Civil Status Service Archive and development of an enterprise content management platform for the entire government. A decision was taken to commence implementation of bridging activities that span M-Cloud Phases 1 and 2.

The Bank and eGC teams reviewed the response to the recommendations resulting from the Court of Accounts review of the project. Most of the issues raised by the Court of Accounts have been sufficiently addressed. Some of the most pertinent pending items resulting from the review by the Court of Accounts are strengthening the management capacity of the eGC and increasing the disbursement rate. The actions proposed by the eGC in their response letter coincide with the actions agreed upon between the Bank and the eGC.

Key priority for the next six month is to expedite project implementation and disbursement particularly under Component 2: e-Services and MCloud.

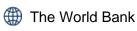

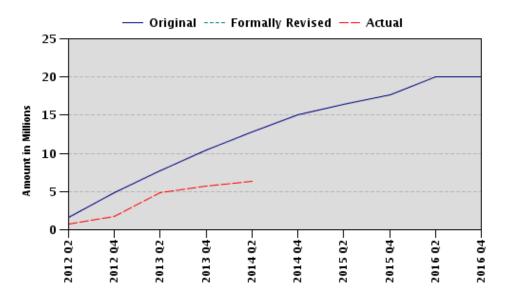

Key Decisions Regarding Implementation

The Government and the World Bank team agreed to the following actions:

- 1. The team estimated and agreed on the target disbursement rate to be achieved by the mid-term review scheduled for May 2014. The agreed upon target is US\$7 million in disbursements and an additional US\$7 million in commitments. This will represent 70% of total IDA loan. The majority of disbursements will be achieved through implementation of ICB#5 (Enterprise Content Management Platform), ICB#6 (2012-13 e-Services), ICB#7 (interoperability platform), and ICB#8 (storage capacity).
- 2. A decision was taken to advance certain activities under the M-Cloud Phase 2, specifically implementation of Disaster Recovery Site given the risk and exposure of data recently migrated to the M-Cloud.
- 3. Discussions were held with the Ministry of ITC about the launch of the ICT industry competitiveness study. The study is aimed at preparing implementation plans, costing, and a cost-benefit analysis for the ICT Competitiveness Strategy. Consensus was reached to proceed with the study and add to its scope planning for the Government's newly-approved strategy, Digital Moldova 2020.
- 4. Agreement was reached to commence feasibility study of the e-Procurement system to be considered for inclusion under the project as an additional service under Component 2: Shared infrastructure and e-Services.
