Dear Liagat sb.

Thanks for sharing with us the internal SMR from HESCO under Tranche 2 of the MFF for January-June 2016. Although there are still improvements that may be made in the report, such improvements may be incorporated in the next SMR. We endorse uploading of this SMR to the ADB website for disclosure. Following are our specific comments:

 In Jacobabad grid station and transmission line subproject, there is still 1 compensation payment for impacts from stringing which is reportedly pending. <u>Recommendation</u>: HESCO needs to facilitate the

issuance of a new cheque to pay compensation for this remaining AP.

In areas where civil works have been completed, the SMR confirmed that these sites were visited and
that the areas have been restored. <u>Recommendation</u>: Please advise HESCO to continue with this
field verification and reporting on the restoration of temporarily used plots and provide documentation
(i.e. photos and statements from some APs) to support the findings.

 In Shikarpur-Larkana transmission line and Sanghar-Kandiari-Mirpurkhas transmission line subprojects, it was reported that stringing has been completed and compensation is being processed. Recommendation: Please advise HESCO to closely monitor the compensation so as to avoid delay in

completing payments.

4. In Dadu-Meher-Larkana transmission line subproject, it was reported that there has been a delay in the compensation payments (i.e. only 51 of the 362 foundations have been made and no compensation has been done for the 48 erected towers. This issue has been brought to the attention of the project director, but the issue remains unresolved. <u>Recommendation</u>: Please advise HESCO to take concrete actions to address the issue and avoid further delay in the compensation payments.

No information was provided in the SMR if there are complaints received so far under the project's
grievance mechanism and the status of their resolution. <u>Recommendation</u>: The next SMR should
report on the number, types of grievances received, actions taken and status of resolution.

6. The SMR includes as annex the social monitoring checklist for contractors, which provides a good summary of the status of the works, compensation and other social concerns in the project. Recommendation: Inclusion of this annex for all ongoing subprojects should be continued in the subsequent internal SMRs. Status of restoration of temporarily used sites and feedback from community or concerns received from APs/stakeholders during the reporting period should also be included in the monitoring sheet.

In general, the SMR highlighted the issue of delayed compensation which was already brought to the attention of the Project Director, but have so far remain unresolved. We need to remind HESCO to act swiftly on this and avoid prolonging its resolution as this deprives those who are affected and exposes the project to risks of complaints.

1. INTRODUCTION OF THE COMPANY

Hyderabad Electric Supply Company Limited; HESCO is a Public Limited Utility Company, established in 1998 under Companies Ordinance 1984 responsible for distribution of Electric Power within its territorial jurisdiction and presently serving around 0.9 Million customers (Domestic, Commercial, Agricultural, Industrial and others) in twelve Districts of Sindh Province.

1.1. ABOUT PROJECT MANAGEMENT UNIT (PMU)

To effectively plan, execute and monitor the Power Distribution Enhancement Investment Program (Tranche II), a Project Management Unit (PMU) has been established under Chief Engineer (Development) comprising of five sections i.e. Planning, Scheduling & Coordination, Procurement, Finance and Environment & Social Safeguard along with the Project Director (GSC) for physical execution of grid stations and transmission lines.

BRIEF DETAIL OF THE PROJECT

Existing conditions of the HESCO power distribution and transmission system are inadequate to meet rapidly growing demand for electrical power. To cope with this situation, the existing power infrastructure has to be improved and upgraded. The overall contribution of power infrastructure requires institutional arrangements, capacity building that support strategic management of the sector, planning and management of investments.

Location of the Project:- The Sub-Projects under Tranche-II are in Sanghar, Mirpurkhas, Shikarpur, Larkana, Sukkur, Badin, Dadu and Jacobabad Districts of Sindh Province.

2.1-OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT

HESCO through GoP has undergone a Project Financing agreement with Asian Development Bank for:

- 1. Strengthening the capacity of Power Distribution and Transmission networks.
- 2. To meet the increasing electricity demand in the selected areas more efficiently.
- To upgrade the existing power infrastructure.

2.2-SCOPE OF WORK

There are 7 Nos. of projects under ADB Tranche-II. Detail is as under:

- 1. Construction of 01 No. of New 132 kV Grid Station and allied Transmission Line.
- Conversion of 03 Nos. of Grid Substations from 66kV to 132kV and allied Transmission Line
- 3. Second Circuit stringing of 02 Nos. 132 kV Transmission Lines
- 4. Construction of 01 No. 132 kV Transmission Line

Overall the proposed MFF has been designed to address both investment and institutional aspects in electric power sector. Development objectives / project purpose will be fully achieved after completion of the proposed Sub-projects.

3. FINDINGS/ OBSERVATIONS OF VISITED PROJECT SITES

Findings/ Observations noted during the site visit. Its details are as follows:

3.1 NEW 132KV JACOBABAD-II GRID STATION SITE AND TRANSMISSION LINE

- The Sub-project is 100 % complete and energized in the month of September 2014.
- HESCO had purchased 8.3 acres of land from one landowner on voluntary sale basis against negotiated price for construction of new grid station. The purchase land was a empty dry patch for no constructive use since 6 years therefore no social impacts were associated with the construction of grid station. (Sale Deed attached in Annexure B).
- However, there were some potential social impacts associated with the construction of transmission line that passed through private farmland affecting crops. The compensation payment of foundation and stringing work was paid to the affectees except one stringing payment due to expiry of the payment cheque.
- The E&SS Cell is continuously following up with the GSC SEPCO to complete the remaining stringing payment and close the compensation record of this sub-project.

3.2 CONVERSION OF 66 KV TO 132 KV SUKKUR GRID STATION AND ALLIED TRANSMISSION LINE

- The sub-project is 100 % complete and energized in the month of August 2014.
- The conversion works were carried out totally within the boundary of the existing grid station without acquiring additional land so there was no potential social impact associated with this part of the subproject.
- The Transmission line consisted of 12 towers and 30 poles. Out of total 12 towers 8 towers fell in private farmland. The compensation for all the foundation and stringing work for these towers has been paid. The details are given in chapter 4 and Annexure D.

3.3 CONVERSION OF 66 KV TO 132 KV LARKANA GRID STATION AND ALLIED TRANSMISSION LINE

- The sub-project is 100 % complete and energized in the month of September 2014.
- The Grid station work was totally inside the existing grid land so no social issues were arisen.
- The transmission line consisted of 12 poles and 3 towers.
- The complete compensation payment has been paid in January 2015.
- Overall the community was happy from the benefits of this sub-project and load management has been achieved by the conversion of grid station.

3.4 CONVERSION OF 66 KV TO 132 KV TALHAR GRID STATION AND ALLIED TRANSMISSION LINE

- The sub-project was energized in August 2014.
- The conversion work was carried out totally within the boundary of the existing grid station without acquiring additional land so there was no any social issue associated with this aspect.
- The compensation payments for the crop damage during the transmission line work were paid on time. (Annexure C)
- Overall the sub-project area community is satisfied by the benefits of this activity.

3.5 SECOND CIRCUIT STRINGING OF 132 KV T/L SHIKARPUR - LARKANA

- The sub-project is complete with stringing of 248 towers.
- The compensation payment is in process with the scrutiny of revenue record.
- Overall the load management situation has improved in the area and the community is over it.

3.6 SECOND CIRCUIT STRINGING OF 132 KV SANGHAR-KANDIARI-MIRPURKHAS T/L

- The sub-project is complete with stringing of 220 towers.
- The compensation payment is in process and total assessment of compensation amount is 3,571,835.
- Public consultation meeting was carried out with general public, adjacent community at the Mirpurkhas Grid station and they gave positive views.

3.7 CONSTRUCTION OF DADU-MEHER-LARKANA 132KV DC T/L (NEW) TRANSMISSION LINE

- The foundation work of 362 towers and 48 erection of towers has been completed and the compensation payments of 51 foundations have been paid.
- Training of the social and environmental aspects are being regularly conducted to the contractor's staff.
- Complaint registers have been placed at the project sites and community has been informed about it along-with Public information brochure.
- There is a delay in the compensation payment and Project Director (GSC), SEPCO has been informed through continuous correspondence to make compensation payments well on time.

5. * SOCIAL SAFEGUARD WORK STATUS

Land Acquisition and Resettlement Plans (LARP):

- (i) All LARPs and DDR Reports in respect of HESCO sub-projects under Tranche-II (both in English & Urdu versions) have been translated, typed/edited and uploaded/ displayed on HESCO official websites. (www.hesco.gov.pk) and at each sub-project site.
- (ii) All the LARPs of subprojects had been revised/updated on actual basis for Tranche-II and the same were submitted to the Asian Development Bank for review.
- (iii) Regular meetings with ESM were held to reach out to the problems at site and fortnightly monitoring sheets were required from them (Annexure A).
- (iv) Urdu version of Environmental Management Plan (EMP) after translation was provided to the Contractors and placed at each grid site during construction work and available at HESCO Website.
- (v) Environmental & Social Complaint Register is made available on each active project site to record complaints of affected household / persons at each project site.
- (vi) Grievance redressal committee has been constituted and documented procedure for grievance redressal is functional (Annexure G).

6- SOCIAL SAFEGUARD AWARENESS AND TRAINING.

On site/ on job trainings were arranged at the Dadu-Maher-Larkana Transmission line sub-project regarding environmental issues, social issues, housekeeping, communicable diseases especially Dengue, Malaria, Airborne, Waterborne diseases & drugs, defensive driving, site restoration after the work and overall implementation of the Land Acquisition and Resettlement Plan (LARP) of the Tranche-II sub-projects.

7- SITE RESTORATION OF COMPLETED SUB-PROJECTS

The completed sub-project sites have been visited to monitor site restoration. It was observed that all the completed sites have been restored. It was also ensured that the locations under the transmission lines are used for agriculture purposes similar to preproject conditions.

8- CONCLUSION

The main issue that needs to be resolved is the timely payment of the compensation to the affectees of the project. As of June 2016, HESCO has completed compensation at Talhar Transmission Line sub-project, Larkana Transmission Line sub-project and Sukkur transmission line sub-project while the stringing payment of the Jacobabad transmission line sub-project is also complete except one effectee. The Sanghar-Kandiari-Mirpurkhas and Shikarpur-Larkana second stringing of transmission line is also complete and the compensation is delayed. The need of the day is to bring the compensation payments in line with the ADB policy of payment before the civil works.


The correspondence with the Project Director SEPCO and HESCO and a continuous follow up through shows their commitment to resolve the compensation issue on time and but still the issue is present.
