Implementation Status and Key Decisions

- 1. The Government of Sri Lanka is currently awaiting clearance from the Attorney General's Department for signature of the Financing Agreement of the project .
- 2. The procurement activities relating to the output and performance based contract are currently ongoing. The Ministry of Finance has decided that the tender documents will be issued only after the project has been made effective (also reflected in the negotiation minutes).
- 3. The milestones to be achieved (i) The Operations manual has been approved on the June 21.9, 2016 prior to the deadline. (ii) The user satisfaction survey which was to be completed by July 31, 2016 has not been conducted. The procurement of consultants to carry out this survey is underway. This delay in not affecting the overall implementation as the user satisfaction survey needs to be completed before the award of the OPRC contract and this is delayed due to the delay in the signing of the legal agreement.
