Excellency:

I refer to the Financing Agreement between the International Development Association in (the "Association") and the Democratic Republic of Congo (the "Recipient") for the thevereferenced project of even date herewith. The Agreements provide that the Association may sue additional instructions regarding the withdrawal of the proceeds of financing IDA 5655 and DA D0670 (collectively "Financing"). This letter ("Disbursement Letter"), as revised from t $r \ge$ to time, constitutes the additional instructions.

The attached World Bank Disbursement Guidelines for Projects, dated May 1, 2006, ("Disbursement Guidelines") (Attachment 1), are an integral part of the Disbursement Let z_{\pm} . The manner in which the provisions in the Disbursement Guidelines apply to the Financing is specified below. Sections and subsections in parentheses below refer to the relevant sections and subsections in the Disbursement Guidelines and, unless otherwise defined in this letter, the capitalized terms used have the meanings ascribed to them in the Disbursement Guidelines

I. Disbursement Arrangements

- (i) Disbursement Methods (.:ection 2). The following Disbursement Methods may be used under the Financing:
 - Reimbursement
 - Advance
 - Direct Payment
 - Special Commitment

(ii) **Disbursement Deadline Date (subsection 3.7).** The Disbursement Deadline Dire is 4 months after the Closing Date specified in the Financing Agreement. Any change is to this date will be notified by the Association.

II. Withdrawal of Financing Proceeds

(i) Authorized Signatures (subsection 3.1).

(iii) Electronic Delivery (subsection 3.4) The Association may permit the Recipien to electronically deliver to the Association Applications (with supporting documents) throug the Association's Client Connection, web-based portal. The option to deliver Application t the Association by electronic means may be effected if: (a) the Recipient has designated in Mr ing, pursuant to the terms of subparagraph (i) of this Section, its officials who are authorized or sign and deliver Applications and to receive secure identification credentials ("SIDC") f cm the Association for the purpose of delivering such Applications by electronic means; and (b) all uch officials designated by the Recipient have registered as users of Client Connection II the Association agrees, the Association will provide the Recipient with SIDC for the de ignited officials. All other supporting documentation for SOEs should be retained by the project management or Recipient and must be made available for review by periodic Association missions and in err d and external auditors.

IV. Other Disbursement Instructions

Two pooled Designated Accounts will be used to comingle proceeds of IDA Financing N(\rightarrow). 670 - and No 5655 to jointly finance eligible expenditures for all Categories of Section IV. A.? of Schedule 2 of the Financing Agreement.

The proceeds of the IDA Finar cings No D0670 - and No 5655 will be advanced into the probled DAs. A combined ceiling (See Section II.vi) has been determined for each DA and vi be allocated to each financing source as follows:

DA.A: US\$2,400,000 f or IDA Grant No D0670 and US\$4,400,000 for IDA Credi No 5655, will finance cligible expenditures under Category 1.a and 2 of Section $\Gamma^{+} = 2$ of the Financing Agreement

DA.B: US\$1,000,000 for IDA Grant No D0670 and US\$1,900,000 for IDA Credit 10.655 will finance eligible expenditures under Category 1.b and Category 3 of Section I¹ A 2 of the Financing Agreement.

Terms and Conditions of Use of Secure Identification Credentials in connection with Use of Electronic Means to Process Applications and Supporting Documentation

March 1, 2013

The World Bank $(Bank)^1$ will previde secure identification credentials (SIDC) to permit the Borr $y = 2^{-2}$ to deliver applications for withdrawal and applications for special commitments under the Agreement (s) and supporting documentation (such applications and supporting documentation together referred to in the errors and Conditions of Use as Applications) to the Bank electronically, on the terms and condition to gethere in the second specified herein.

SIDC can be either: (a) hardware-based (Physical Token), or (b) software-based (Soft Token). The 3 sk reserves the right to determine which type of SIDC is most appropriate.

A. Identification of Users.

- 1. The Borrower will be required to identify in a completed Authorized Signatory Letter (ASL) (1) delivered to and received by the Bank each person who will be authorized to deliver Appl calors. The Bank will provide SIDC to each person identified in the ASL (Signatory), as provide the ow. The Borrower shall also immediately notify the Bank if a Signatory is no longer authorized to the Borrower to act as a Signatory.
- Each Signatory must register as a user on the Bank's Client Connection (CC) website
 (<u>https://clientconnection.vrorldbank.org</u>) prior to receipt of his/her SIDC. Registration on CC will require that the Signatory establish a CC password (CC Password). The Signatory shall rorreveal his/her CC Password to anyone or store or record the CC Password in written or other form. Upon registration as a CC user, the Signatory will be assigned a unique identifying account name.

<u>B.</u> Initialization of SIDC.

- 1. Prior to initialization of S DC by a Signatory, the Signatory will acknowledge having read, understood and agreed to be bound by these Terms and Conditions of Use.
- 2. Where a Physical Token is to be used, promptly upon receipt of the Physical Token, the Sigr tory will access CC using his/lier account name and CC Password and register his/her Physical Token and set a personal identification number (PIN) to be used in connection with the use of his/ne Physical Token, after which the Physical Token will be initialized for use by the Signator a exclusively for purposes of delivering Applications. Where a Soft Token is to be used, the

Signatory will access CC using his/her account name and CC Password and set a personal identification number (PIN) to be used in connection with the use of his/her Soft Token, a ter which the Soft Token will be initialized for use by the Signatory exclusively for purposes of delivering Applications. Upon initialization of the SIDC, the Signatory will be a "SIDC User The Bank will maintain in its database a user account (Account) for each SIDC User for p_{1} p ses of managing the SIDC of the SIDC User. Neither the Borrower nor the SIDC User will have the ny access to the Account.

3. Prior to first use of the SIDC by the SIDC User, the Borrower shall ensure that the SIDC '1.e: has received training material: provided by the Bank in use of the SIDC.

C. Use of SIDC.

- 1. Use of the SIDC is strictly limited to use in the delivery of Applications by the SIDC Use in the manner prescribed by the Bank in the Agreement(s) and these Terms and Conditions. An $r \to r$ are use of the SIDC is prohibited.
- 2. The Bank assumes no responsibility or liability whatsoever for any misuse of the SIDC by h. SIDC User, other represet tatives of the Borrower, or third parties.
- 3. The Borrower undertakes to ensure, and represents and warrants to the Bank (such represent a ion and warranty being expressly relied upon by the Bank in granting SIDC) that each SIDC 11 en understands and will abide by, these Terms and Conditions of Use, including without limitation the following:

4. Security

4.1. The SIDC User shall not reveal his/her PIN to anyone or store or record the PIN in v_{T} ten or other form.

4.2. The SIDC User shall not allow anyone else to utilize his/her SIDC to deliver an Application to the Bank.

4.3. The SIDC User shall always logout from CC when not using the system. Failure t + c out properly can create a route into the system that is unprotected.

4.4. If the SIDC User believes a third party has learned his/her PIN or has lost his/her Hys cal Token he/she shall immediately notify <u>clientconnection@worldbank.org</u>.

4.5. The Borrower shal immediately notify the Bank at <u>clientconnection@worldbank.ctife f</u> any lost, stolen or compremised SIDC, and take other reasonable steps to ensure such SII C is disabled immediately.

5. Reservation of Right to L isable SIDC

5.1. The Borrower shall reserve the right to revoke the authorization of a SIDC User to ι so a SIDC for any reason.

5.2. The Bank reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to temporarily or permanently d s w = a SIDC, de-activate a SIDC User's Account or both.

6. Care of Physical Tokens

6.1. Physical Tokens w ll remain the property of the Bank.

6.2. The Bank will physically deliver a Physical Token to each Signatory designated to receive one in a manner to be determined by and satisfactory to the Bank.

6.3. Physical Tokens contain delicate and sophisticated instrumentation and therefore should be handled with due care, and should not be immersed in liquids, exposed to extreme temperatues, crushed or bent. Also, Physical Tokens should be kept more than five (5) cm from devices that generate electromagnetic adiation (EMR), such as mobile phones, phone-enabled PDAs, such a phones and other similar cevices. Physical Tokens should be carried and stored separate form any EMR device. At close rarge (less than 5 cm), these devices can output high levels of EMR that can interfere with the proter operation of electronic equipment, including the Physical Token

6.4. Without derogating from these Terms and Conditions of Use, other technical instructions on the proper use and care of Physical Tokens are available at http://www.rsa.com.

7. Replacement

7.1. Lost, damaged, compromised (in terms of 4.5, above) or destroyed Physical Token w l be replaced at the expense of the Borrower.

7.2. The Bank reserves the right, in its sole discretion, not to replace any Physical Toke 10° the case of misuse, or not to reactivate a SIDC User's Account.
