I have reviewed the SMR for T2 and T3 submitted by IESCO. I endorse acceptance and uploading of the SMRs for disclosure. Please advise use when these have been disclosed so we can reflect in our monitoring matrix.

T2 subprojects are substantially completed. Compensation payment is also completed except for 2 subprojects (TL Mangla Power House to Rajjar GS, and Hattian-Bagh TL. Site restoration in completed works have been monitored and confirmed. Complaints received, including status, are now reflected in the monitoring report.

T3 subprojects are at different stages of implementation. Compensation payments are in progress following the construction work. Some complaints on timing of compensation payments have been reported, including actions made to expedite payment. Please remind IESCO to continue to pay close attention in providing timely compensation in order to avoid complaints from the DPs.

1.1 IESCO

1. Islamabad Electric Supply Company Ltd. (IESCO) is a public utility company, having more than 02 Million consumers and provides service to 04 Nos. Northern Districts of the Punjab Province (Rawalpindi, Attock, Jhelum and Chakwal); Capital Territory (Islamabad); and Southern parts of Azad Jammu & Kashmir (AJK). IESCO jurisdiction map is placed at **Annex - A**.

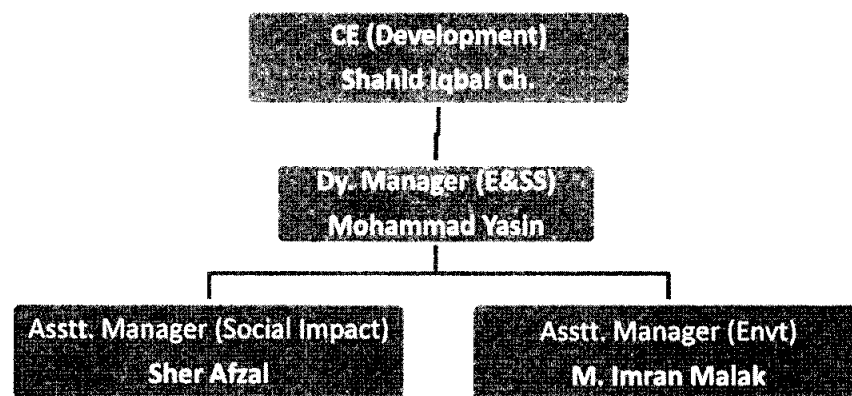
1.2 Directorate of CE (Development) / Project Management Unit (PMU)

2. To carry out and handle investment projects IESCO has established Project Management Unit (PMU) under the supervision of Chief Engineer (Development). The PMU comprises of four sections. The organizational structure of PMU - IESCO and main responsibilities of each section are given in **Annex-B**.

1.3 Environmental & Social Safeguard Section - P MU

3. The Environmental & Social Safeguard (E&SS) Section of PMU, IESCO provides an overall supervision and advisory services during the Pre - Construction phase, Construction phase & Post - Construction phase of the project. The unit also assists and advises GSC Directorate, Construction Directorate and other IESCO departments on environmental and social matters overall. Organizational structure of E&SS - MU IESCO is attached as below.

4. IESCO Tranche – III subproject includes 03 No. constructions of new Grid Stations, 04 Nos. Extension, 09 Nos. Augmentation, 05 Nos. Transmission Lines (New), and 03 No. Transmission Lines (Remodeling). The detailed scope of work of Tranche - III subprojects is attached at **Annex – C**.

2.1 Present Status of Civil Work.

7. The civil works of following 132 KV T/lines sub-projects of Tr - III have been awarded, and the execution of civil works are also underway. The detail of works awarded is provided below in table 2.1.

2.2 Orientation session for Contractors

8. In this period (July-Dec 2016) orientation sessions for M/s SINO STEEL Equipment & Engineering Corporation, China was arranged on 29-08-2016 to

discuss environment social safeguard and security issues. The E&SS officers paid a field visit on 13-12-2016 and found that the contractor is not fulfilling the requirements of environment, social safeguards and security measures.

9. IESCO raised the same issue with contractor and also informed the ADB officials who arranged a meeting for contractor in ADB resident office Islamabad to make sure the implementation of environment, social and security measures for smooth completion of the project.

2.3 Project Impacts

2.3.1 Replacement of Sangjani - Zeropoint 132 KV Transmission Line

12. This sub-project is in construction phase. The 22.5 KM replacement of Sangjani - Zero Point 132 kV transmission line subproject is traversing i) government land, ii) three housing societies in Islamabad; iii) two villages of Islamabad and iv) Jangi Sydian village of district Rawalpindi. The transmission line route already exists and one more tower/pole is added in-between two existing towers without acquiring any additional land. None of the household has been physically displaced or lost more than 10% of their productive assets.

2.3.2 Replacement of Burhan- New Wah 132 KV Transmission Line

13. This sub-project is in construction phase. The replacement of Burhan - New Wah 132 kV transmission line subproject is located in Attock District of Punjab. The 9.66 Km transmission line is traversing Private cultivated and broken land, government land, one Housing society and five villages, of District Attock. The transmission line route already exists but the construction activities have affected the crops of 238 HH. No land is acquired permanently for this subproject. None of the household is being physically displaced or lost more than 10% of their productive assets.

2.3.3 Replacement of existing New Rawat - Sowon 132 KV T / Line

14. New Rawat to Swan 132kV transmission line subproject is located in Islamabad. The sub-project has been completed by the GSC Directorate of IESCO and energized. The 9.45 Km transmission line traversed Private cultivated and broken land, three Housing societies. The construction activities of transmission line temporarily affected crops and trees of 20 households. None

of the household has been physically displaced or lost more than 10% of their productive assets.

2.3.4 132 KV Chakri Road Grid Station & Feeding Transmission Line

15. This sub-project is in construction phase. The grid station is being constructed on IESCO's own 32 kanal Land situated on chakri road located at about 20 km from Rawalpindi Sadar. To feed this Grid Station a new 15.75 km transmission line (TL) is also being constructed. No land acquisition process is involved in this subproject. The transmission line is traversing through private barren and cultivated land of five villages, temporarily affecting crops and trees. Till date the construction activities have affected the crops of 80 Nos HH. None of the household has been physically displaced or lost more than 10% of their productive assets.

2.3.5 132 KV Sangjani Grid Station & Feeding Transmission Line

16. The proposed grid station will be constructed in Multi Professional Housing Society (MPHS). The land has been acquired free of cost from the society. To feed this grid station a 02 Km long 132 KV transmission line will be constructed from the existing 220 KV grid station Sangjani. The construction activities will affect crops of 02 households. None of the household will be displaced or lose more than 10% of their productive assets.

2.3.6 KTM (I-16) - Chakri Road 132 KV Transmission Line

17. This sub-project is in construction phase. The KTM (I-16) - Chakri Road 132 kV transmission line subproject is located in Islamabad and Rawalpindi District of Punjab. The 11.5 Km transmission line is traversing through private barren and cultivated land of four villages. The construction activities of transmission line have temporarily affect crops and trees of 67 households. None of the household has been displaced or lost more than 10% of their productive assets.

2.3.7 In & Out construction at Chakri Sub-Station 132 KV T/ Line

18. The In & Out construction at Chakri Sub-Station 132 kV transmission line subproject is located in Rawalpindi District of Punjab. The sub-project has

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been completed by the GSC directorate of IESCO and energized. The 22.5 Km transmission line traversed through private barren and cultivated land of seven villages. The construction activities of transmission line have temporarily affected crops and trees of 422 households. None of the household has been physically displaced or lost more than 10% of their productive assets. Compensation amount of PKR 4,184,100/- has been paid to all the 422 Nos households affected by the construction of T/line.

2.3.8 Construction of Bara Kahu Grid Station and feeding 132 KV T/ Line

19. The new relocated 40 kanal site is located near Barakahu Islamabad. The project site is accessible from Barakhu. The grid station site has been purchased by IESCO from private society on mutually agreed rate of Pak Rs. 0.6 million per Kanal. The proposed grid station will be connected to the existing 132 kV Transmission line University – Nilor.

20. The proposed 132 kv feeding line is about 10 km having approx. 47 poles /towers) passing hilly area and some forest area with shrub and sparse tree cover. The Transmission line will be constructed in the barren areas of the foot hills excluding the houses or any other public infrastructure or the private land. The proposed feeding will be connected to existing 132 kV Transmission line University – Nilor.

2.4 Compensation Assessment and Payments

21. The detail of compensation assessment and payments is tabulated below. Phase wise breakup is provided at Annex-E. The subproject wise list of PAPs, whose compensation has been assessed/ paid in current period i.e July to December 2016, is attached at Annex- F.

2.5 Site Restoration.

22. IESCO being a responsible public utility company takes care of public interest specially compensation payment for damages and restoration of sites. All the contractors have been made aware of the proper back filling of earth work and site restoration after completion of works. IESCO environment and social officials also monitor the site restoration of completed sites during field visits. IESCO tries to ensure the site restoration to its original shape and wherever un-restored sites comes into notice, the contractor is immediately advised to make arrangement for proper restoration of the same. All the completed sites of Tranche -III sub-project sites have been properly restored.

2.6 Awareness & Trainings.

23. One orientation session has been conducted on 13-12-2016 for site staff and labors of M/s SINO STEEL Equipment & Engineering Corporation, China in this bi-annual period.

2.7 Grievance Redress Mechanism (GRM).

24. To GRM exist in IESCO to address and resolve the complaints & issues of Project Affected Persons (PAPs). IESCO has constituted a Grievance Redressal Committee (GRC) inline of the ADB Social Safeguard Policy. The committee members are as follow:

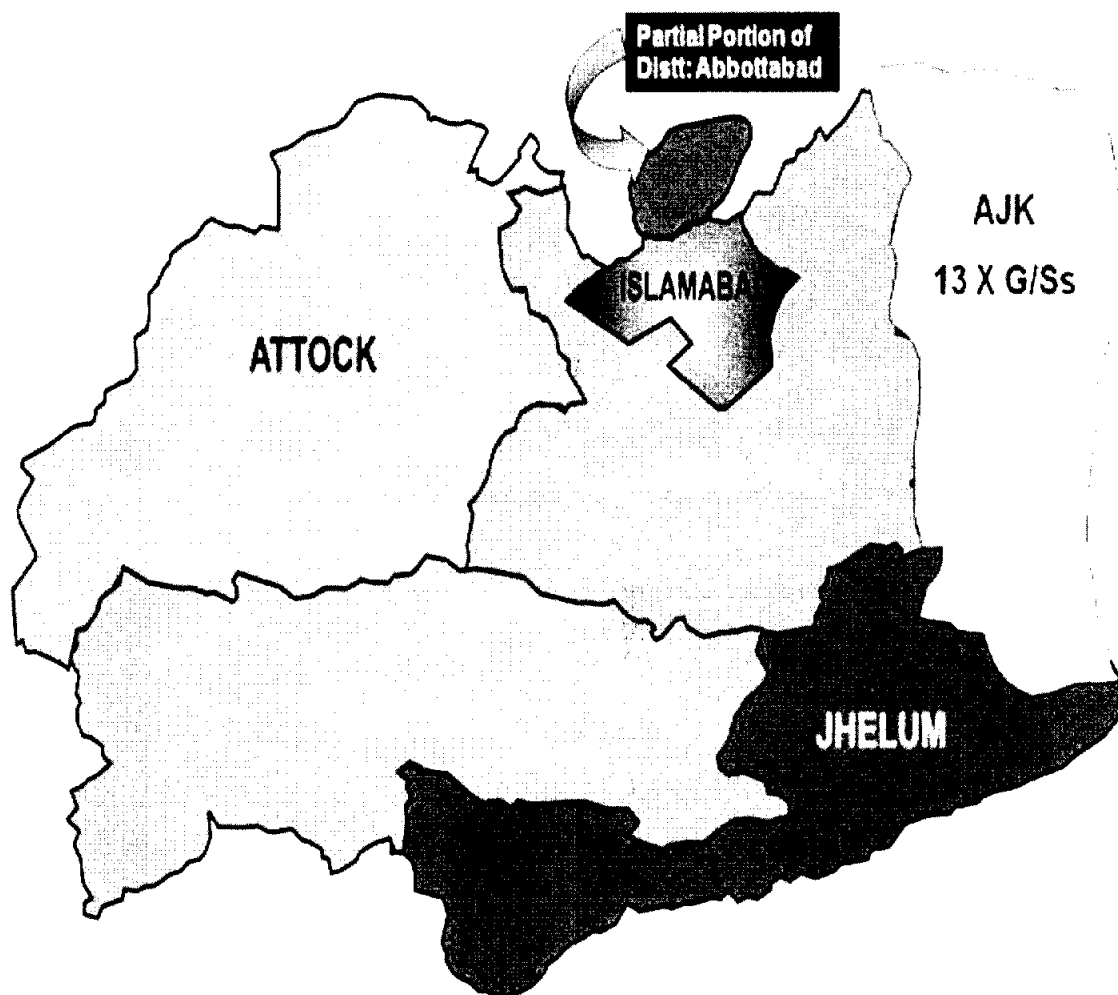

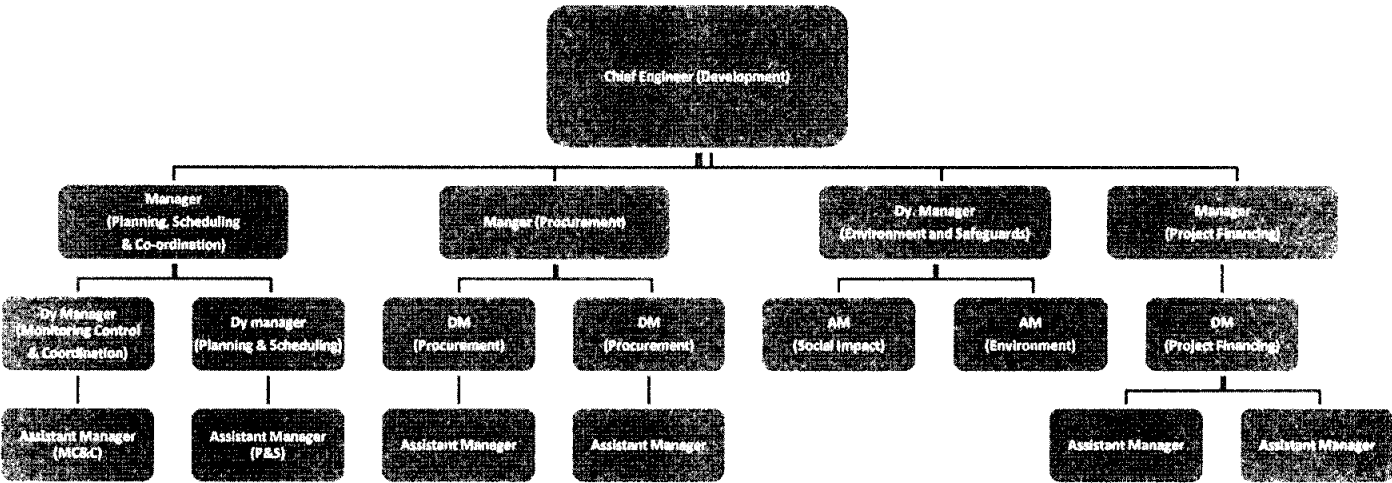

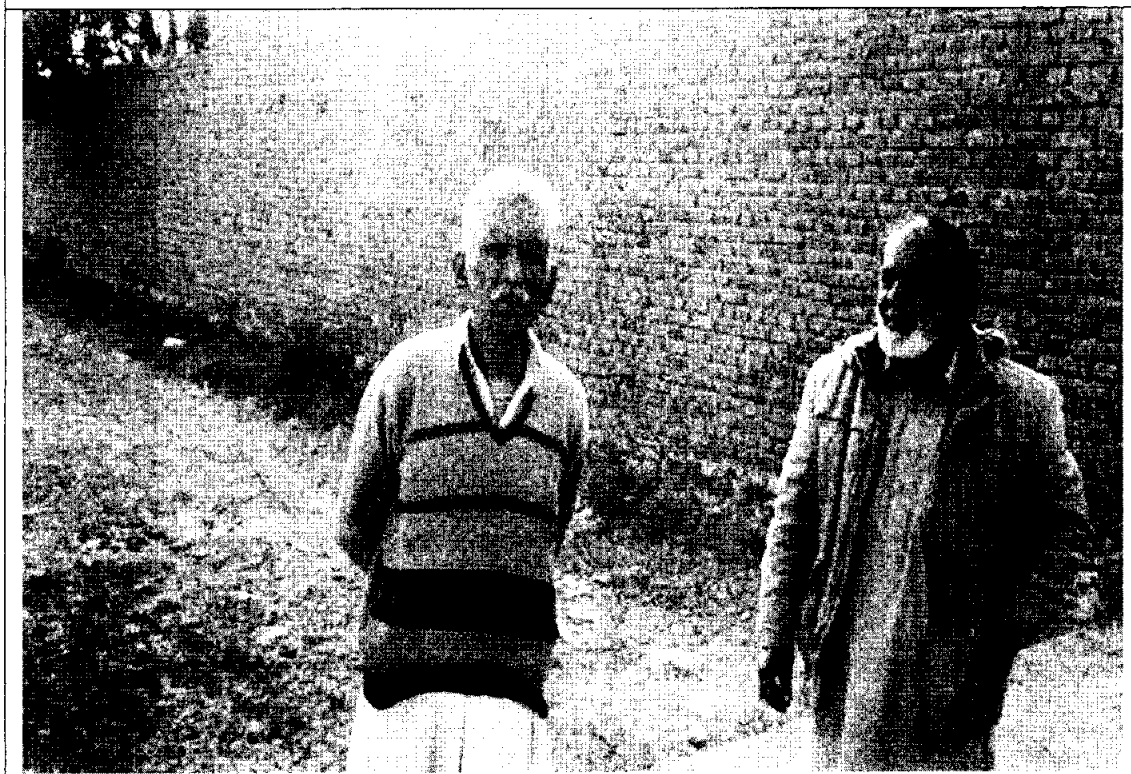

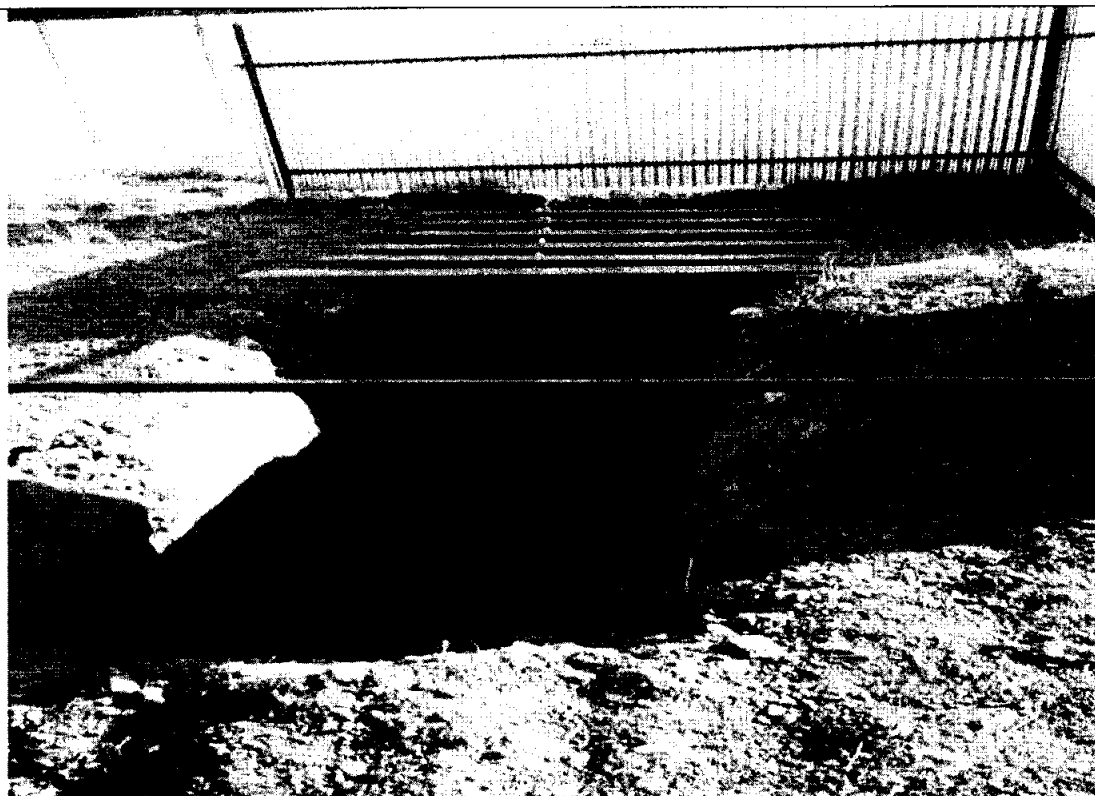
