# Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The Project was declared effective on September 12, 2014. After an extended procurement process two key positions have now been filled. The Project Director commenced his assignment on May 2, 2015. The Project's Research Assistant has been contracted and will be mobilized in early July 2015. Additional administrative support (in particular an executive assistant), including to support the Project's communications and outreach efforts. A firm to develop the Project website/ portal will be hired. In addition the technical, economic and legal advisory assistance is expected to be recruited later in 2015.


