### Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The Project was declared effective on September 12, 2014. Key Project staff postions--Project Director, Researcher and Executive Assistant--have been recruited and mobilized following extended procurement processes. A firm to develop the Project website/ portal will be hired; this will build on the materials developed in the Phase 1 of this program; USP will take responsibility for website hosting. In addition short-term technical, economic and legal consultants are expected to be recruited in the first half of 2016.

The Business Plan and Workplan for 2016 have been completed and approved in principle by the Project Steering Committee. The main objectives of the Business Plan are:

- 1. Improved quality and reliability of information on the sector in the region: there will be a strong focus in 2016 on establishing an up to date set of sector indicators
- 2. Improved regulatory and technical capabilities of member countries: through a combination of technical notes and seminars
- 3. Strengthened interregional cooperation and collaboration among the regulators, the private sector and policy makers of the Pacific Island Countries: this will also include collaboration agreements, for example with ITU, GSMA, APT, the Pacific Islands Telecommunications Association (PITA) and the Council of Regional Organizations in the Pacific agencies.
- Improved access to knowledge services by Pacific member countries: a series of technical notes will be delivered in 2016, plus regional knowledge events
- 5. Improved awareness of the project among stakeholders (including economic development ministries and agencies) and the public: through a revamped Project website, and targeted oureach
