About this position

We are looking for a proactive, detail-oriented and meticulous research assistant consultant. As research assistant you will support the design, implementation and evaluation of the AI-powered "Profe Gabi" teacher induction and mentoring system in its 2025 deployment.

You will work in the Division of Education (SCL/EDU) part of the Social Sector Department. This team is responsible for supporting education systems of Latin America and the Caribbean countries to reach five dimensions that will contribute to making them successful in promoting effective teaching and learning among all children and youth

The objective of this consultancy is supporting the implementation of "Profe Gabi," an AI-powered chatbot focused on providing support to early-career teachers in Chile. Specifically, the consultant will support the IDB team in the design and implementation of the RCT evaluating "Profe Gabi" in its 2025 deployment, including by providing data analysis and general project management support.



What you'll do:

- **Review feedback from the pilot and support the team in making adjustments**: Assist in analyzing feedback from the 2024 pilot phase of "Profe Gabi," identifying areas for improvement, and supporting the team in making necessary adjustments to enhance the chatbot's effectiveness and user experience.
- **Prepare databases to identify different treatment groups**: Help in organizing and preparing databases to categorize participants into different treatment groups (e.g., Treatment 1, Treatment 2, and Control). Ensure that the data is accurate, complete, and ready for analysis.
- **Support in preparations for 2025 launch**: Support all stakeholders in preparing technology for launch and ensuring that systems are set up to reach the totality of participants.
- Data Collection and Analysis, and ongoing Database Management: Assist in collecting and organizing data from the deployment of "Profe Gabi," including user engagement metrics, feedback from teachers, and performance outcomes. Analyze the data to identify trends and insights that can inform project improvements. Help manage and maintain project databases, ensuring that all data is accurate, up-to-date, and securely stored. This includes cleaning and organizing data according to guidelines provided by the IDB.
- **Report Preparation**: Support the preparation of progress reports, final reports, and other documentation required for the project. This includes drafting sections of reports, creating visual aids (charts, graphs), and ensuring that all information is accurate and well-organized. Support in drafting of report presenting results from the RCT.
- **Communication and Coordination**: Facilitate communication and coordination between project stakeholders, including the Ministry of Education (MINEDUC), the IDB team, and the consulting firm. This may involve scheduling meetings, preparing meeting agendas, and documenting meeting outcomes, or other additional tasks as required.
