Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The Montenegro Industrial Waste Management and Cleanup Project was approved on by the Bank's Board of Directors on September 19, 2014 and became effective on November 10, 2014. The objective of the Project is to reduce contamination of Montenegro's natural resources and public health risks of exposure to this contamination from selected industrial waste disposal sites. These sites are the Bijela shipyard, a mine tailings disposal site in Gradac, a coal ash disposal facility in Pljevlja and two industrial waste disposal sites at the aluminum smelter complex in Podgorica. In addition, the Project will also provide support to further develop the regulatory framework for hazardous and industrial waste management in Montenegro. The Project is implemented by the national Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) under the Ministry of Sustainable Development and Tourism (MSDT). The EPA has for this purpose established a Project Management Unit (PMU) and is supported by the Technical Services Unit (TSU under Ministry of Finance) for Procurement and Financial Management tasks.

A brief mission was conducted during September 29 - October 1, 2014, to discuss initiation of project implementation. Particular attention was paid to the full operationalization of the PMU to implement the Project and commence activities. Outstanding PMU vacancies were all recruited by December 15, 2014.
