Program Development Objectives

Program Development Objective (from Program Appraisal Document)

The Program Development Objective (PDO) is to improve (1) the efficiency of land administration, (2) the regulatory framework for private investment in fiber optic infrastructure, (3) services provided by investment promotion agencies and public-private partnership units, and (4) the efficiency and transparency of government-to-business services in participating states.

Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The Nigeria State Action on Business Enabling Reforms (SABER) Program became effective on June 14, 2023 after the government met all the effectiveness conditions per the Financing Agreement (FA), namely: (i) issuing a satisfactory legal opinion on the FA, (ii) engagement of the independent verification agent (IVA) for the Prior Results, (iii) establishment of the SABER Program Coordination Unit (PCU) through the hiring and appointments of key personnel, and (iv) adoption of the Operations Manual.

To support states towards achieving the Year 1 disbursement-linked results (DLRs) and the remaining Eligibility Criteria (EC), sensitization events, ad-hoc technical assistance (TA) sessions and training programs for the states were facilitated by the PCU, the Presidential Enabling Business Environment Council- Enabling Business Environment Secretariat (PEBEC-EBES), and the Nigeria Governors' Forum (NGF). The PCU in collaboration with NGF and PEBEC-EBES led the state sensitization events on the ECs and the Year 1 results for Disbursement Linked Indicator (DLI) 2 (Improved regulatory framework for private investment in fiber optic infrastructure). The NGF led the sensitization event on DLI 1 (Improved efficiency in property registration and sustainability of the land-based investment process), DLI 3 (Development of an effective PPP framework) and DLI 7 (Simplified state and local business tax regimes), while the PEBEC-EBES led the state workshops on DLI 4 (Improved investment promotion environment), DLI 5 (Increased transparency of official fees and procedures), DLI 6 (Increased transparency of fees and levies for inter-state trade and increased exporter certification) and DLI 8 (Quick determination of commercial disputes).

The primary objectives of these workshops were to: (a) sensitize state officials on the SABER Program; (b) disseminate comprehensive information on the ECs, DLI matrix and the Program Verification Procedures, and (c) showcase successful state examples to serve as an example to other participating states. The sensitization sessions included sharing templates and key documentation to support states in achieving the ECs and the DLRs. Customized feedback was provided to individual states to guide their progress towards the achievement of results. On August 24, 2023, PEBEC-EBES conducted a state sensitization workshop on effectively preparing and monitoring state-level Business Enabling Reform Action Plans (BERAP), one of the ECs for states to be eligible for financing under SABER. Additional TA sessions are scheduled to commence after the completion of the sensitization meetings. NGF extended bilateral TA to states on the preparation and publication of one of the ECs - the Annual Fiscal Year (FY) 22 State Audited Financial Statement (AFS) due to be completed by July 31, 2023.

The assessment by the IVA for the Prior Results is currently underway and is anticipated to conclude by early October. The procurement process of the annual IVA assessment for the Program (eligibility criteria + years 1-3) has also been initiated by the PCU.


