Dear Requesters,

This is to inform you that we have examined your Request and will register it in accordance with paragraph 20 of the MICI Policy.

As you were previously informed, the registration is an administrative procedure that begins the eligibility analysis to determine whether we can process your Request, based on the criteria set forth in paragraph 22 of the Policy. The steps that will be taken in the coming weeks are as follows:

- 1. <u>Management's Response</u>: The team responsible for the project is being simultaneously informed of the registration of your Request so that they can respond to the issues raised therein, offering the perspective of the Bank's Management. They have a maximum of 21 business days from today's date to draft the response.
- <u>Eligibility analysis</u>: Once we receive Management's response, we will issue our determination within 21 business days through an eligibility memorandum. The deadline for the issuance of the memorandum is <u>July 26, 2016</u>.

Within the next few days the record of your Request will be entered into the Public Registry of the MICI's website (<u>www.iadb.org/mici</u>), where you can check the status of your Request and where all of the public documents pertaining to the case will be published.

During this period, we will most likely need to communicate with you and it is possible that a MICI delegation will be visiting Asunción. We thank you for your availability, and will be happy to answer any questions you may have about the process.
