### Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The Nicaragua Improving Community and Family Health Care Services Project was approved by the Board on December 7, 2010 and became effective on April 4, 2011. As of August 06, 2015 the Project has disbursed US\$20.5 million (64% of the IDA credits and grant). Following the results of the remaining technical audits, it is expected that the Project will disburse an additional US\$2.9 million in capitated payments and the arrival of equipment will trigger the remaining funds. The Project is expected to reach 100% disbursement by its closing date in January 2016.

The Project is progressing well towards achieving its Project Development Objectives of improving the access and quality of preventive and promotion of health and nutrition services among poor and vulnerable population; and strengthening the operational capacity of the Ministry of Health. The Project result indicators are expected to be achieved by the end of Project.


