Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The Grant agreement between the World Bank and Government was signed on October 27, 2015. However, the project is still not yet effective. The Draft Ratification Decree has already been prepared by the Government's Secretariat. The main pending actions for the effectiveness of the grant are: (i) the approval by the parliament (ii) the approval by the Council of Ministers, (iii) the Ratification Decree by the President as well as its publication and (iv) the legal opinion. These pending actions, encounter some delays due to non-convocation of parliament session. The project effectiveness deadline has been extended from February 27 to June 27, 2016. There is a high risk of cancellation of the Grant if the project is not declared effective by June 27, 2016.

The delay in effectiveness of the project will further delay the implementation of the population census due lack of resources readily available for financing some of the complementary activities needed to implement the cartography, mainly IT equipment and generators. The Government has asked the Bank about the possibility of the project financing the purchase of those equipment so as to accelerate the cartography. There is a risk, however, that the proposed solution will not be implemented promptly due to the fact that the project is not yet effective. The team has conveyed to the Government the importance of resolving issues related to the approval of project, so as to avoid delaying the implementation of the population census.

Hiring of a project coordinator: The coordination of the project was supposed to be performed by the General Director of the National Institute of Statistics (NIS) who has so far, combined both the functions of head of the NIS and coordinator of the PRINS project (P125509). When the Statistics Development Project (PDS) becomes effective, the General Director of INS, in addition to these two functions, will be responsible for coordinating a new project. Experience has shown that it is difficult to efficiently perform such multiple tasks. The volume and complexity of activities of the two projects (PRINS and PDS) require that a full time coordinator.

Furthermore, in the first year of the PRINS project, three General Directors have been appointed as successive heads of the NIS, which means that the project has had three different coordinators in just one year. Such repeated changes negatively affect the successful implementation of the project.

To stabilize the management team of PRINS and PDS projects, the team has suggested that (see detail in Aide-memoire):

- (i) The functions of General Director of the National Institute of Statistics and the Coordinator of the projects be separated and that a coordinator be recruited for the two projects through a competitive process satisfactory to IDA;
- (ii) The Coordinator of the projects would report to the General Director of INS who would ensure the General Supervision function of the two projects on behalf of the Government; and
- (iii) The General Director of the INS, the Coordinator of the two projects and the Financial Management Specialist will handle the signatures for the respective project accounts.

In addition to the Project Coordinator, ToRs have been drafted to hire: an Accountant and a Monitoring and Evaluation Specialist to complete the PIU; a resident expert to support the INS for the preparation and implementation of the next household survey; an HR specialist to support the PIU for the implementation of activities designed for the strengthening of HR system and a team of consultants to carry out the Institutional Assessment of the INS.


