

## Implementation Status Overview

Progress toward meeting the project's development objective could be deemed satisfactory by judging only based on the key monitoring indicators. Gansu has met all indicators specified in the results framework for year 2013 except for the number of heritage sites with approved culture conservation plans which stands at 6 compared to the target of 7, the exception being Maijishan. Gansu made good efforts over last six months trying to get the approval of the Maijishan Culture Heritage Conservation Plan by the State Administration of Culture Heritage (SACH) and will visit SACH again in July 2014. However, the inadequate site operations plan for all nine project sites and the substantially delayed culture heritage conservation work in Maijishan, and the lack of competent staff both for the Gansu Provincial Project Management Office (GPPMO) and two field construction supervision companies will hinder full achievement of the PDO with respect to "the development of sustainable cultural tourism". GPPMO and Maijishan have been working diligently on the bidding



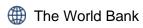
documents for two culture heritage conservation contracts for the Maijishan sub-project, but progress is very slow. That said, there is a risk that these two conservation contracts will not be completed by the extended loan closing of December 31, 2014.

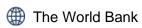



# **Key Decisions Regarding Implementation**

GPPMO needs to make further efforts to engage staff with specific sectoral knowledge and expertise in cultural and natural heritage conservation, tourism development, related infrastructure services development and construction, and tourist destination management. The borrower also needs to strengthen the technical capacity of two construction supervision companies so that all remaining works can be completed in a timely manner and with good quality, especially in Maijishan. The next supervision mission is scheduled for August 2014 and the preparation of the Borrower's implementation completion report will also be discussed then.
