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#### **Implementation Status Overview**

Between March 2009 and May 2011, the Bank program in Madagascar has been guided by OP/BP 7.30 - Dealing with de facto Governments. The achievement of the results of the project were undermined by the difficulty to engage with government and the lack of funding. Recent authorization to resume disbursements has yet to impact positively on the achievement of expected results.



### **Key Decisions Regarding Implementation**

On May 7, 2011, the Country Management Unit (CMU) received the authorization from the MDO to extend the OP/PB 7.30 exception regime to encompass additional operations, including the Governance and Institutional Development Project II. As a result of this decision, the Project Implementation Unit (PIU) developed an interim work plan (May - October, 2011) submitted to the World Bank for non-objection. The interim work plan proposes to resume the activities under components 1 (Improvement of Public Expenditure Management) and 4 (Social Accountability). These two components showed positive trends towards the achievement of results despite of the technical suspension of the project over the past two years. In addition, the interim work plan supports the operations of the Global Distance Learning Network (GDLN). Over the next few months, the project will be substantially restructured to adapt its objectives to the current country context.
