Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The Enhanced Nutrition Project for Mothers and Children Project is supported by a US\$36.24 million equivalent IDA Credit for Sindh province, and a US\$ 11.71 million multi-donor trust fund grant for Balochistan province. The Project aims to support both provinces to increase the coverage of nutrition-specific interventions that are known to improve the nutritional status of children and mothers. The Project was declared effective in Sindh on January 15, 2015 and in Balochistan on March 27, 2015.

The team is pleased to note that the project has progressed considerably since the last mission. The progress was possible due to close oversight and management support and commitments by the project teams in both provinces. In Sindh, of the seven actions agreed, three actions have been completed, three have made considerable progress, and one requires a final decision to reach completion. This includes recruitment of all key staff, field level implementation of service delivery both by PPHI and NGOs including facility and village level activities started in two priority districts with availability of essential nutrition supplies. In Balochistan, out of the seven actions agreed, four actions were fully completed and others have made progress and were partially completed. Key positions, including District nutrition officers, are filled, orientations and trainings have been completed and district work plans were developed, operating costs for LHW have been made available, oversight structures are activated. In both provinces, a solid action plan for reaching full scale field level implementation by end September is in place.

It was agreed that in **Balochistan** service delivery at community and facility level through PPHI and LHWs will start immediately in addition to finalization of seven contracts with NGO for provision of services in LHW un-covered areas by15th August. Finalization of logistics and distribution plan to all remaining locations to have essential nutrition supplies available at the implementation level (F75/F100, RUTF, MNPs, IFA, Zinc, equipment) by 31st of August. It was also agreed that the contracts for i) providing management and capacity building support and ii) establishment of a 3rd party monitoring; will be finalized by 15th September.

The key decisions for **Sindh** are:i)Service delivery at facility and community level through PPHI and LHW program for the remaining seven districts should reach full scale by 30th September;(ii)Finalization of contracts with NGO for provision of services in three districts; re-advertise and rebid for contracting partner for the remaining four districts;(iii)Finalization of provision of nutrition supplies to all facilities and partners for the remaining districts by 31st August;(iv)Finalization of the contracts for technical assistance and capacity building support; finalization of the contract for 3rd party monitoring by 30th September.

The next implementation support mission is planned for mid-October 2016.






