

## **Implementation Status Overview**

This is an initial Implementation Status Report for the Enhanced Nutrition Project for Mothers and Children Project, a US\$36.24 million equivalent IDA Credit for the Sindh province. To support the Balochistan province, the project is co-financed by a Grant provided through the programmatic trust fund for the Pakistan Partnership for Improved Nutrition, administered by the Bank in an amount of US\$11.71 million. The project will help both provincial governments to increase the coverage of nutrition-related health interventions that are known to improve the nutritional status of children under two years of age, of pregnant and of lactating women. In addition, it will build institutional capacity to manage and deliver



nutrition interventions. The project was approved by the Board on August, 29, 2014. Due to the political unrest in the country, the signing of the Financing and Project Agreements had been delayed for two months. The signing has now been done on October 31, 2014. Project effectiveness is expected to be declared by end November 2014.




