### Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The project is on track to achieve its Development Objective, this ISR is based on technical review missions conducted by the task team on a regular basis over the six month period. The three portfolios under Sindh-Global Partnership for Education project Human Resource Management Information System (HRMIS), Sindh School Monitoring System (SSMS) and Communication are progressing well, key implementation and procurement activities have been completed.

The Department has made good progress in institutionalizing the HRMIS and SSMS portfolios. Utilizing the data analysis from these portfolios, detailed individual meetings with all 29 districts of the province were held in November and December 2016. Very clear specific tasks have been given to the districts to address issues related to closed schools, teacher placement and absentee teachers. M&E staff identified more than 40,000 absentee teachers and non-teaching staff. Districts were tasked with submitting show cause notices to the absentee staff. A significant improvement in teacher presence has been seen in schools that have been continuously monitored over the last 6 months.

More than 6000 staff have been identified as absconders in the system through the biometric profiling done for the HRMIS and SSMS. Removal of these 6000 staff from the payroll and stoppage of wasteful release of salary to absconder staff has been a very positive step towards an efficient HR management. Better HR management will help remove the stigma of ghost teachers from the education department.

The Department successfully completed the Annual review of the Sector Plan as part of its communication activities. The Joint Education Sector Review was attended by all major stakeholders including international development partners.
