Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The Government has had a good start in initiating HRMIS and setting up of the SSMS. The SSMS activity has been initiated on a pilot basis in 5 districts across Sindh and a data dashboard for maintaining monthly visit report data has been created. However, the teams of both these units need to be fully staffed to ensure program activities can continue as planned.

A Communication team has been created in the RSÚ, and a draft communication strategy has been prepared and presented to ELD. Implementation on the strategy needs to be planned by the department both for internal and external communications. An advocacy and awareness raising campaign has been initiated for certain key reform areas.
