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Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The Ministry of Public Education (MoPE) continues to make progress towards project implementation, though several shortcomings remain, especially in terms of procurement and monitoring and evaluation. Moderate delays persist with the implementation of the first and third project components, and the Bank's team is working closely with the MoPE to address these current implementation challenges. The World Bank and the MoPE have agreed on a proposal to restructure the Project, which would use existing savings to expand the project scope and also extent the project closing date to allow time for the successful completion of all current and revised project activities.
