#### Implementation Status and Key Decisions

Nine months into implementation, the Project is making steady progress despite an increasingly difficult operating environment. With the prolonged processes involved in securing access letters and MOUs from the Interim Taliban Administration (ITA) as well as difficulties in procuring the six Facilitating Partner (FP) packages, the Project has experienced some delays. The female NGO worker ban based upon the Dec 24 edict and the WB-issued contract pause also contributed to some delays over the past 1.5 months. On the rural side, implementation is proceeding with eight FPs on board and with access letters from ITA. As of February 15, 2023, Component 1 (Emergency Livelihoods Support and Services in Rural Areas) is operating in 3,497 rural communities in 17 provinces. Community profiles and beneficiary lists have been completed for 2,376 communities, and 1,515 community subprojects have been identified. Twelve subprojects are under implementation. Component 2 (Emergency Livelihoods Support and Services in Urban Areas) is active in eight cities with 44 ongoing and 12 completed projects generating 212,207 labor days, benefitting 11,070 households. Under Component 3 (Social Grants for Women and the Most Vulnerable in Rural and Urban


