EBRD/EIB would be responsible for managing environmental and social risks of the latter in accordance with their policies, which are substantially the same as WB SG policies, so it was not felt necessary to apply WB SG policies in addition;</p> <p>Environmental and social safeguards requirements of EBRD and EIB are substantially the same as the World Bank's. The Bank reviewed the specific application of these requirements by EBRD and confirms the compliance with the requirements of the environmental safeguards of the World Bank.</p> <p>The Bank will ensure that any potential financial implications of environmental or social issues associated with the reforms to enable modernization of Ukraine's gas transit system (e.g. possible environmental or social liabilities associated with past or current pollution from storage facilities) are duly taken into account in the financial analyses and projections. To this end, the bank will review progress reports, including safeguards compliance, from PIU and consultants funded from the grant. Once a year WB specialists will meet with safeguards team of the Consultant to review the results of the work.</p>
