- Review international experiences on investments in infrastructure for the provision of long-term care or healthcare for older people, including models such as day centers, geriatric hospitals, and other care facilities.
- Identify and analyze selected investment proposals or priority contexts in Latin America and the Caribbean, assessing their technical, financial, and institutional pre-feasibility.
- Develop a cost-benefit analysis and financing options assessment for each investment proposal, including potential funding sources such as public budgets, IDB loans, private sector participation, and blended finance.
- Draft each pre-feasibility study, ensuring analytical rigor, policy relevance, and actionable recommendations for the region.
- Incorporate comments and revisions from the IDB team and peer reviewers.
- Participate in periodic technical meetings with the IDB team to discuss progress and validate the content of the studies.

We are seeking a motivated, committed, and experienced consultant to develop a study on digital labor platforms for home-based long-term care in Latin America and the Caribbean.

The consultant will work in close collaboration with the Social Protection and Labor Markets Division (SCL/SPL) team, contributing to the analysis of how digital labor platforms are shaping the provision of home-based long-term care services, examining their operational models, regulatory frameworks, implications for care workers, and potential for expansion in the region, with reference to international experiences.

What you will do

- Prepare a concept note including the research questions, analytical framework, methodology, data sources, and annotated outline of the study, in coordination with the IDB team.
- Conduct a systematic review of the literature and map the landscape of digital labor platforms operating in the home-based long-term care market in Latin America and the Caribbean and in selected comparator countries.
- Analyze the business models, operational features, governance structures, and geographic coverage of digital labor platforms for home-based long-term care in the region.
- Examine the regulatory frameworks applicable to digital labor platforms in the care sector, including labor rights, social protection coverage, and quality assurance mechanisms for care workers and users.
- Assess the implications of digital labor platforms for the quality, accessibility, and sustainability of home-based long-term care, and identify opportunities and risks for scaling these models in LAC.
- Draft the study, ensuring analytical rigor and policy relevance, with actionable recommendations for governments, regulators, and other stakeholders.
- Incorporate comments and revisions from the IDB team and peer reviewers.
- Participate in periodic technical meetings with the IDB team to discuss progress and validate the content of the study.
