## Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The Kyrgyz Republic has fulfilled all conditions precedent to the project effectiveness, and consequently, the project was declared effective on February 26, 2016.

This ISR covers the implementation support mission conducted from March 28 to April 1, 2016. Implementation progress is now rated satisfactory. Despite the delay in effectiveness, preparatory activities are progressing well. This progress is due to the utilization of: (i) the ECAPDEV which enabled the development of technical guidelines and the project operational manual, and was 97% disbursed at closure; and (ii) a State and Peacebuilding Fund grant which has supported the first round of village investment planning and capacity building activities in communities and local governments. It is currently 48% disbursed. As a result, the social mobilization activities are complete and the competitive process envisaged for Aiyl Aimaks (AAs) is well underway. 204 subproject proposals and 161 small grant proposals were submitted by AAs by March 15, 2016. These will progress through Oblast and National selection committees with final decisions expected by May 15, 2016 and disbursement for these local investments starting in June 2016.


