However, in the interests of promoting global aviation security, a limited level of disclosure will apply whereby charts depicting the level of implementation of the Critical Elements of an aviation security oversight system by a Member State and an indication of compliance by a Member State with Annex 17 Standards, as well as information pertaining to the existence of unresolved Significant Security Concerns (SSECs) in a Member State, will be made available to all Member States on the USAP secure website.
