The objective of the overall APL Program are as follows: (a) improve efficiency and equity in the planning and regulation of the health service delivery system; (b) reduce preventable deaths among emergency medical cases; (c) improve access and quality health care in poor and remote areas; and (d) help the Romanian health sector to better focus on priority public health problems, thereby reducing preventable illness and deaths. The specific objectives of Phase 2 are as follows: (i) Provide more accessible services, of increased quality and with improved health outcomes for those requiring maternity and newborn care and emergency medical care; and (ii) Provide support for the preparation of the primary health care strategy.

Implementation Status Overview

The Project closing date has been extended for the fourth time by 3 months to March 15, 2013 in order to allow the completion of the following specific ongoing activities: (i) delivery of the surgical instruments for gynecology; (ii) delivery and installation of the last equipments of the filling and sealing line for vaccines at Cantacuzino Institute; (iii) TA for the evaluation of the financial impact of the newly envisaged health sector reform law and (iv) training for the Health Technology Assessment are expected to be completed by mid-March 2013. All other activities envisaged under the project have been completed. So far, the budgetary allocation to support the implementation of project activities continues to be adequate.

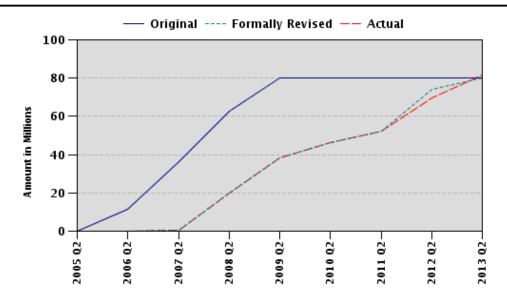
