Implementation Status Overview

Progress towards achievement of PDO has been down graded to Moderately Satisfactory. Out of the two PDO indicators, the reduction of costs to formally start business end target of 70% will not be reached (actual 83.7, DBR 2013 (source)) but Growth of turnover in firms accessing BUGS at 62% (June 2012 BUGS Impact Assessment Report), is higher than the 20% end Target. Thus the first PDO indicator was close to being reached while the second one was exceeded. Overall implementation Progress has been downgraded to



Moderately Satisfactory mainly due to a number of intermediate results indicators not being met.

Following the signing of the Amended EU/World Bank administration Agreement in January 2011, a Grant Agreement between the Government of Malawi and the World Bank (as administrator of the EU grant) was signed on 18 May, 2011 and the EU co-financing of US\$ 3.7 million started being utilized to finance agreed activities that were part of the project design. A second order restructuring (re-allocation of proceeds) was also approved by the Acting Country Director in April 2011.

Actual IDA expenditure to date, including commitments was at 99.9%. All EU funds were committed by 31 December 2011 as agreed and because of the delay in the signing of the Grant Agreement, the ending date of the EU Trust Fund was retroactively extended from 31 December, 2011 to 30 June, 2012 with a grace period for all payments being extended to 31 October, 2012 (i.e four months after the closing the Trust Funds) in order to complete all EU Trust Fund activities. All EU Trust Fund goods and services were delivered by 30 June, 2012. The closing date of BESTAP will remain 31 December, 2012 as originally scheduled.

All fiduciary aspects of the project are satisfactory. The project procurement and financial management are currently rated as satisfactory, and have been since project effectiveness. Financial management is Satisfactory and the project is up-to-date with Interim Financial Reports (IFRs) as well as Audit Reports.

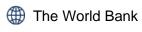

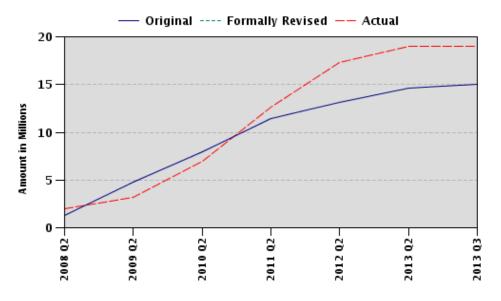
