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Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The project's financing agreement was signed on September 23, 2015. The government has initiated efforts to attain project effectiveness at the earliest. The government's commitment to the project remains strong and significant progress towards achievement of effectiveness and disbursement conditions has been made but the project is yet to become "Effective".

The government has established a Project Management Unit (PMU) at the Economic Affairs Division (EAD) to supervise and administer project activities. Key positions have been filled and the PMU is operational. The National Database and registration Authority (NADRA) the implementation agency for the project has initiated the procurement process for equipment and services under the project.

The project stakeholders (EAD, NADRA, FATA Disaster Management Authority (FDMA) and FATA Department of Health (DoH)) have reached an understanding with the Ministry of States and Frontier Regions (SAFRON) to establish two One-Stop-Shops in North Waziristan and another two in Kurram Agency by December 2015.

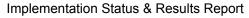

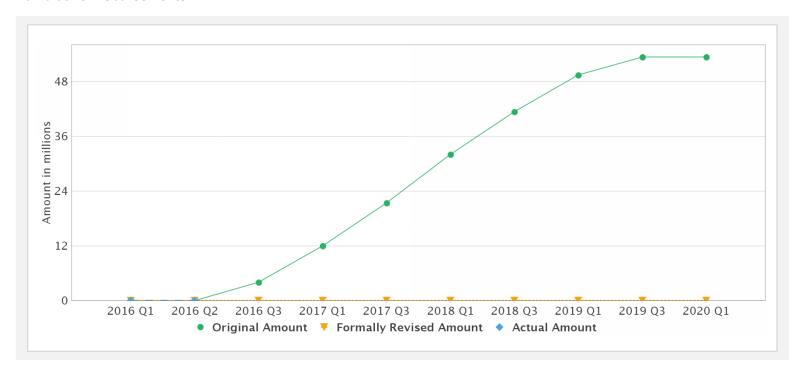
