Implementation Status and Key Decisions

Implementation of the project has been started in August. PMU has mobilized consultants and facilitator teams in Sinabung. The facilitator and project staffs, and also government staffs have been trained and field work to organize communities has progressed with close coordination with local government of Kabupaten Karo. Manuals have been finalized and series of meeting to produce a national framework for disaster management among Ministry of Public Works and Housing (MPWH), National Agency for Disaster Management (BNPB) and related national agencies has being

continuously carried out. Field activities were further delayed from original plan due to uncertainty of the extent of Mount Sinabung eruption. Following are some activities that need to be carried out by Government of Indonesia: (a) Revise the Government Post-disaster Action Plan to modify official estimates of the Mount Sinabung eruption period and also update policy on reconstruction, temporary shelter and relocation; (b) Expedite a joint work-plan between the Min. of Public Works and Housing, BNPB / Agency for Disaster Management, related agencies and the IDF Secretariat.


