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Implementation Status and Key Decisions

Project implentation is recovering from initial delay and has disburesed USD 1 million to the WSTF. One subsidy has been paid out in tranche 1 and partial payment in tranche 2 for Murang'a South Water and Sewerage Company. The pipeline has 8 potential projects in various stages of seeking finance. Significant progress has been made on enhancing quality improvement of the implementation unit due to strong support of senior management of the Water Services Trust Fund and the World Bank task team. The World Bank has provided procurement and financial management guidance as well as direct support to the program manager. The contract for the IVA has been signed with the WSTF.

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
