Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The Uganda Teacher and School Effectiveness Project (UTSEP) is financed through a grant from the Global Partnership for Education (GPE) in the amount of USD100 million to support the Government of Uganda in improving teacher and school effectiveness. The Project is implemented by the Uganda Ministry of Education, Science, Technology and Sports (MoESTS), with the World Bank acting as Supervision Entity on behalf of the GPE. The grant was declared effective on March 24, 2015.

To facilitate implementation, a Project Implementation Manual (PIM) is in place, as well as a mainstreamed Project Coordination Unit (PCU) supported by a team of 8 consultant specialists. Annual work plans and budgets were also developed and approved by the Local Education Group (LEG). It is impressive to note is that Government's ownership of the project has improved manifest in the regular implementation review meetings, proactivity in seeking help from the World Bank task team members, and improved quality of documentation submitted to the World Bank for review. A two-day orientation workshop for the entire project implementation team was undertaken as an integral part of the effectiveness mission to ensure common understanding of the project objectives, funding modality and implementation arrangements for respective project interventions. Implementation planning has been done with involvement of beneficiary local governments to the detail possible, while the procurement of literacy and numeracy instructional material for all public primary schools has been initiated.

Key decisions for disclosure include the following:

- 1. The UTSEP project will scale up the ongoing leadership training program for head teachers and School Management Committee (SMC) members. The certificate program is offered by Uganda Management Institute (UMI) in partnership with the Royal Netherlands Embassy. The scale up will benefit 2000 schools drawn from the project districts. The decision was endorsed by the Local Education Group (LEG) on March 23, 2015; justified by the need to standardize the training provided to primary school head teachers across the country.
- 2. The Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Public Service (MoPS) consented to the technical assistance towards improvements in the teacher pay roll management and Scheme of Service (career progression for teachers) under the UTSEP project.
- 3. USAID and UNICEF will work with the World Bank to ensure quality and timely implementation of the Project, in regular consultation with the Local Education Group.
