Implementation Status and Key Decisions

The Sahel Women Empowerment and Demographic Dividend regional project (SWEDD) was approved on December 18, 2014 for 5 countries (Chad, Cote d'Ivoire, Mali, Mauritania and Niger) and one regional partner (West African Health Organization or WAHO). Burkina Faso was added through an additional financing, approved on April 23, 2015. All the 7 Financing Agreements (FAs) are now effective, the last one being Niger in November 2015. Except Burkina, all recipients are disbursing. Project teams are fully in place for 5 of the 7 recipients, the process being close to completion in Niger and Chad. Overall, all the SWEDD implementation arrangements are now in place.

The next phase to be completed is the "harmonization" one. As mentioned in the Project Appraisal Document (PAD), most of the SWEDD activities require various iterations between national and regional levels to ensure that all country activities are in line with the regional objectives of the SWEDD and are taking full advantage of opportunities for regional collaboration. The harmonization phase is now ongoing and will be completed in June 2016.
