

Implementation Status Overview

The Social Safety Net Project (SSNP) has made progress in various areas since its approval on March 25, 2014. The project met all conditions of effectiveness (issuance of the legal opinion, parliamentary approval, and submission of the revised Project Implementation Manual) and became effective on August 29, 2014. Beyond this the project has undertaken a range of preparatory activities drawing on retroactive financing arrangements, namely: (i) procuring key staff and equipment for social protection systems development; (ii) advancing development of the Management Information System (MIS) and (iii) preparing detailed handbooks and tools for key project operational processes. The first disbursement is expected by October 15, 2014.



In addition, to support Government's response to the Ebola crisis, the project reprogrammed approximately US\$26,000 to support the immediate stabilization and mitigation measures, in particular to conduct information and communication activities and social mobilization in the four targeted districts to help contain the spread of the disease and thus minimize the impacts on extremely poor households. The initiative, which is implemented by the National Commission for Social Action (NaCSA) in partnership with the Ministry of Health and Sanitation, is expected to conclude in October 2014.




