The Government of Suriname hereby formally requests a Non – Reimbursable Technical Cooperation (TC) in the amount of USD 200.000,= from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) to support the technical design of the recently requested loan operation Skills for Life and Work Improving Education Opportunities and Competitiveness through Bilingual Education and Technology.

The objective of this TC is to support the Ministry of Education, Science and Culture (MOESC) to develop a strategy to strengthen teaching of English as a second language. This will include a review of connectivity options for schools, teaching modalities and pedagogy, and identification of teacher training and equipment needs. These activities are important to the Government of Suriname because we are seeking to expand our global opportunities through improved English language skills, both for the economic development of our nation as well as professional growth for our citizens. The identified teaching modalities eventually could be applied to the teaching of other languages such as French, Spanish and Portuguese.

In order to reach all students, we aim to increase the number of schools with an internet connection beyond the current 325 and improve the quality of the service, including better bandwidth, fewer service interruptions and options for reaching schools in the interior. This would allow for hybrid education and expand learning opportunities for students. Finally, we require international technical assistance to determine how to strengthen the MOESC's Education Management Information System to support the teaching model and the sharing of information through better connectivity.
