<b>Project Description</b>	<p>The Project will contribute to the achievement of the first five years of the development plan of PT. Perusahaan Listrik Negara (Persero, the state electricity company) (“PLN”) for the East Java and Bali regions under the 2019-2028 Electricity Business Plan (RUPTL), consisting of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>a) construction of 17,000 km of medium-voltage distribution lines</li><li>b) installation of 1,500 MVA of medium-voltage distribution transformers</li></ul>
<b>Objective</b>	To improve access to and quality of power services by strengthening the power distribution network in East Java and Bali.
<b>Expected Results</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>a) Medium-voltage distribution lines constructed: 17,000 km</li><li>b) Medium-voltage distribution transformers installed: 1,500 MVA</li><li>c) Number of households with increased access to electricity (grid and non-grid): 12,415 million</li><li>d) Distribution interruption: tbd</li></ul>

Based on this examination, commensurate E&amp;S safeguard instruments will be developed in consultation with PLN to establish the processes to follow and standards to be implemented by PLN for the preparation, implementation and monitoring of distribution system sections to be financed by</p>
