I. PROJECT STATUS AND RATIONALE FOR RESTRUCTURING

- This paper seeks the approval of a project restructuring to extend the project closing date to October 31, 2023, revise the Results Framework and disbursement projections. The project was approved by the Board on June 27, 2013, (US\$102.9 million, IBRD loan) supporting four components: (A) Rehabilitation and Modernization of Irrigation and Drainage Systems Infrastructure; (B) Sustainable Management, Operation and Maintenance of Irrigation and Drainage Systems; (C) Agricultural Development; and (D) Project Management, Technical Assistance and Training. The project became effective on January 29, 2015. The project is originally designed to be implemented within seven years and expected to be closed by the end of December 2021.
- 2. Delays have been compounded by various reasons over the project period including:
 - a. Lengthy internal Government procedures for signing and parliamentary ratification;
 - b. Conflict of interest in the tendering process of the implementation support consultant, followed by the Bank Operations Procurement Review Committee review and resolution;
 - c. Government budget procedures, which required the project feasibility study to be revised and updated via a lengthy process to determine budget allocations for investments;
 - d. Erratic project financing from the State Budget Program with no project funds available at the start of the calendar year until 2019; and
 - e. Spread of COVID-19 pandemic and associated restrictions, that have considerably hit project implementation.
- 3. The project remedial actions agreed upon with the Client at in-depth mid-term review of October 2018, and closely followed up through a series of Bank missions afterwards, proposed a two-step project restructuring approach. First restructuring was approved in May 2019, when the overall disbursement ratio was less than 7 percent, with project implementation progress rated unsatisfactory. Intermediate result indicators were adjusted to reflect revisions to intermediate targets due to delays in implementation, as well as adjustments to end targets given the availability of additional information since project appraisal. A second step was the extension of the project closing date subject to improved implementation.
- 4. COVID-19 has had a massive impact on construction contracts of the project. A few contracts had stopped for some period, with the intention to resume work on a later date. At this stage, COVID-19 is no longer an absolute obstacle to contracts completion, but it has slowed them down, causing delay and disruption, due to severe disruption in supply chains and labor. As the COVID-19 situation is still evolving, further issues can still arise to some extent.
- 5. Currently the project is reporting steady progress with the total disbursement of 40.74 percent and project implementation progress upgraded to moderately satisfactory. Main procurement activities have been completed and all civil works contracts are now under implementation, committing most of the project funds (90 percent of loan proceeds) and, leaving some space for contracts cost increase due to significant price increases of construction materials. Most contracts are progressing satisfactorily except for the COVID induced delays. The project financing has been confirmed in the State Budget Program for calendar years 2021 and early 2022. The Government, through a letter from the Ministry of Finance dated October 13, 2021, requested (i) a twenty-four-month extension of the project closing date to have all works contracts completed and to deliver the project outcomes, and (ii) adjustment of the intermediate results indicator for Component 2 to align the project with the institutional changes in the country and the actual situation.
- 6. The implementing agency has no outstanding safeguards issues nor overdue audit reports.

II. DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED CHANGES

- 7. The project is proposed to be extended by twenty-two-months till October 31, 2023, based on the revised implementation schedule, discussed and agreed upon with the project Implementing Agency (Committee of Water Resources / The Ministry of Ecology, Geology and Natural Resources) during the last implementation support mission in April 2021 and reconfirmed in October 2021. This would be the first extension of the project closing date. The proposed extension will allow delivery of project outcomes and project ratings can be further upgraded. PDO objectives are expected to be achieved.
- 8. The intermediate results indicator for Component 2 is proposed to be changed from original "Operational water user associations created and/or strengthened" to "agricultural cooperatives strengthened". The Law on agricultural cooperatives dated October 29, 2015 dissolved and/or reorganized the Rural Consumer Cooperatives of water users (RCC- the form of water user associations in Kazakhstan) to agricultural cooperatives from January 1, 2016. The responsibility for water management was transferred from RCCs to KazVodKhoz Republican State Enterprise (KVK), a public institution. The project will pilot a participatory approach and irrigation management transfer from KVK to two selected agricultural cooperatives that will be strengthened under the project.
- 9. End target dates and intermediate target values for all indicators are proposed to be adjusted to reflect the extension of the project closing date. Disbursement projections will be formally revised to reflect changes in the implementation schedule. The proposed restructuring will align the project with the institutional changes in the country and the actual situation on the ground.
