SSS Justification: CDB and UNFCCC at COP16 and COP 29 Presidencies designate a single company (pending to be disclosed) to manage all official events for the COP Blue Zone Pavilions & Offices. This procedure is eligible as included in the "Policy for the selection and contracting of consulting firm form Bank execute operational work (GN-2765-4)."
