Additional Instructions: Disbursement Letter

Excellency:

I refer to the Letter Agreement ("Agreement") between the Republic of Cameroon ("Recipient") and the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development and the International Development Association (collectively, the "World Bank"), both acting as administrator of grant funds provided by UNDP ("Donor") under the Central African Forest Initiative Implementation Single-Donor Trust Fund ("CAFI"), for the above-referenced project, of even date, herewith. The Agreement provides that the World Bank may issue additional instructions regarding the withdrawal of the proceeds of Grant TF0A4147 ("Grant"). This letter ("Disbursement Letter"), as revised from time to time, constitutes the additional instructions.

The attached World Bank Disbursement Guidelines for Investment Project Financing, dated February 2017, ("Disbursement Guidelines") (Attachment 1), are an integral part of the Disbursement Letter. The manner in which the provisions in the Disbursement Guidelines apply to the Grant is specified below. Sections and subsections in parentheses below refer to the relevant sections and subsections in the Disbursement Guidelines and, unless otherwise defined in this letter, the capitalized terms used have the meanings ascribed to them in the Disbursement Guidelines.

I. Disbursement Arrangements

- (i) Disbursement Methods (section 2). The following Disbursement Methods may be used under the Grant:
 - Reimbursement
 - Advance
 - Direct Payment
- (ii) Disbursement Deadline Date (subsection 3.7). The Disbursement Deadline Date is 4 months after the Closing Date specified in the Agreement. Any changes to this date will be notified by the World Bank.

(iii) Disbursement Conditions (subsection 3.8). Please refer to the Withdrawal Condition(s) in Section 3.02 of the Agreement.

II. Withdrawal of Grant Proceeds

(i) Authorized Signatures (subsection 3.1). A letter in the Form attached (Attachment 2) should be furnished to the World Bank at the address indicated below providing the name(s) and specimen signature(s) of the official(s) authorized to submit Applications:

(ii) Applications (subsections 3.2-3.3). Please provide completed applications for withdrawal, together with supporting documents, through the World Bank's Client Connection, web-based portal, following the instructions for electronic delivery. In the case the recipient does not have internet access, the World Bank may permit the delivery of applications for withdrawal, together with supporting documents, in accordance with subsection 3.3, to the following address:

(iii) Electronic Delivery (subsection 3.4) The World Bank may permit the Recipient to electronically deliver to the World Bank Applications (with supporting documents) through the World Bank's Client Connection, web-based portal. The option to deliver Applications to the World Bank by electronic means may be effected if: (a) the Recipient has designated in writing, pursuant to the terms of subparagraph (i) of this Section, its officials who are authorized to sign and deliver Applications and to receive secure identification credentials ("SIDC") from the World Bank for the purpose of delivering such Applications by electronic means; and (b) all such officials designated by the Recipient have registered as users of Client Connection. If the World Bank agrees, the World Bank will provide the Recipient with SIDC for the designated officials. Following which, the designated officials may deliver Applications electronically by completing Connection which accessible through Client Form 2380, is (https://clientconnection.worldbank.org). The Recipient may continue to exercise the option of preparing and delivering Applications in paper form. The World Bank reserves the right and may, in its sole discretion, temporarily or permanently disallow the electronic delivery of Applications by the Recipient.

(iv) Terms and Conditions of Use of SIDC to Process Applications. By designating officials to accept SIDC and by choosing to deliver the Applications electronically, the Recipient confirms through the authorized signatory letter its agreement to: (a) abide by the Terms and Conditions of Use of Secure

Identification Credentials in connection with Use of Electronic Means to Process Applications and Supporting Documentation ("Terms and Conditions of Use of SIDC") provided in Attachment 3; and (b) to deliver the Terms and Conditions of Use of SIDC to each such official and to cause such official to abide by those terms and conditions.

(v) Minimum Value of Applications (subsection 3.5). The Minimum Value of Applications for Reimbursements and Direct Payments is equivalent of USD 50,000

(vi) Advances (sections 5 and 6)

- Type of Designated Account[s] (subsection 5.3): Segregated
- Currency of Designated Account[s] (subsection 5.4): XAF
- Financial Institution at which the Designated Accounts Will Be Opened (subsection 5.5): A Financial Institution acceptable to the Bank
- Ceiling (subsection 6.1) XAF 60,000,000

III. Reporting on Use of Grant Proceeds

- (i) Supporting Documentation (section 4). Supporting documentation should be provided with each application for withdrawal as set out below:
 - For requests for Reimbursement:
 - o Statement of Expenditure in the form attached (Attachment 4);
 - Records evidencing eligible expenditures (e.g., copies of receipts, supplier invoices) for payments against contracts/payments valued at USD 50,000 or more; and
 - List of payments against contracts that are subject to the World Bank's prior review, in the form attached (Attachment 5).
 - For reporting eligible expenditures paid from the Designated Account:
 - O Statement of Expenditure in the form attached (Attachment 4);
 - Records evidencing eligible expenditures (e.g., copies of receipts, supplier invoices) for payments against contracts/payments valued at USD 50,000 or more;
 - List of payments against contracts that are subject to the World Bank's prior review, in the form attached (Attachment 5); and
 - A reconciliation of the Designated Account, in the form attached (Attachment
 6), with a copy of the bank statement.

• For requests for Direct Payment: records evidencing eligible expenditures, e.g., copies of receipts, supplier invoices.

(ii) Frequency of Reporting Eligible Expenditures Paid from the Designated Account (subsection 6.3): Monthly.
