#### Implementation Status and Key Decisions

- First withdrawal applications have been submitted by PCMU, DDM, DNCC and RAJUK on March 15, April 26, May 12 and June 8, 2016 respectively. PCMU, DDM, DNCC and RAJUK have already been notified by the Bank on March 23, May 4, May 25, and June 14, 2016 respectively.
- 2. A Training Exercises and Drills ToR has been drafted, which should receive inputs from all of the primary agencies covered by the firm consultancy DDM, DNCC, DSCC, FSCD and SCC. DDM PIU has circulated the ToR among the stakeholders on May 17, 2016 and held a Consultation Meeting on June 14, 2016. It was agreed that the ToR with inputs will be sent to World Bank for No Objection by June 30, 2016 and the Eol will be floated by July 31, 2016. It is to be noted that the ToR should reflect appropriately the objectives set out in this project.
- 3. DNCC PIU floated the tender of Warehouse construction works on March 30, 2016 and bids were received on May 3, 2016. Warehouse construction works contracts of DNCC, DSCC and FSCD are expected to be signed by July 31, 2016.
- 4. The Search and Rescue (SAR) and ICT Specialist Individual Consultants of DNCC have signed the contract on June 1, 2016.
- 5. SAR equipment / goods tender of DNCC is expected to be floated by June 30, 2016. In total, there will be seven packages, five (5) packages for FSCD and two (2) packages for City Corporations.
- 6. After submitting draft environmental screening report of warehouse construction sites to the World Bank, World Bank requested for site specific report for social and environmental screening. DNCC will hire one short-term consultant with having knowledge in both social and environmental aspects for incorporating World Bank's comments and finalizing the social and environmental impact screening / assessment report.
- 7. RAJUK PIU has agreed to a revised timeline for floating the EoIs for Urban Resilience Unit D&S, Vulnerability Assessment (B1) and Development of Risk Sensitive Land Use Planning (B2) by June 30, 2016
- 8. PCMU signed the contract of PIU goods on March 15, 2016. DNCC floated the tender for procuring PIU goods on April 19, 2016 and bids were received on May 30, 2016. DNCC has already received major items of goods from the selected vendor. RAJUK and DDM have agreed to the revised deadline of July 15, 2016 and July 31, 2016 respectively for floating tender of PIU goods.


