Developmental Objectives	This Project is expected to have a highly developmental impact in Rwanda classified as a low-income country; Kenya, Tanzania, Zambia, and Zimbabwe, lower middle-income countries; and South Africa, a upper middle income country.
Environment and Social Assessment	This Project has been reviewed against DFC's categorical prohibitions and determined to be categorically eligible. Expansion and operations of medical clinics and medical equipment warehousing and distribution services are screened as Category B under DFC's environmental and social guidelines because impacts are site specific and readily mitigated. The major environmental and social concerns include the need for oversight and monitoring of environmental, labor, health and safety including of contractors and other human resources aspects, in particular, worker's grievance mechanism, occupational health and safety, medical waste management, and emergency preparedness and response. Medical devices need to comply with the internationally recognized standards of safety.
