According to ADB website, the TA will provide the Government tools to better direct and balance PPP project outcomes in the short term, and then set the stage for more holistic and sustainable national management of PPPs. For the MOEP, the TA will help the Government establish fair and balanced terms for private sector investment into power generation projects, establish principles for international competitive tendering, assist the Government in prioritizing PPP investment projects, and strengthen the design and management of future PPP procurements.
