### **Project Description**

According to ADB website, the grant aims at mitigating the adverse social and economic impacts on the poor resulting from Typhoon Yolanda (international name Haiyan) in the Eastern Visayas. The outcome will be that the populations in 74 poor municipalities affected by Typhoon Yolanda have access to emergency support and early recovery systems and are more resilient during future disasters. The grant outputs are in 3 components:

- 1. Local government unit infrastructure is restored, and access to emergency employment and livelihood support is provided
- 2. Basic emergency maternal and child health care services are provided
- 3. Improved resilience to future disasters and effective project management, coordination, monitoring, and reporting are achieved
