1. Conduct assessments of existing water supply and solid waste management systems, including surveys and stakeholder consultations
2. Develop water supply and solid waste investment strategies for Dili to help identify and prioritize project components for the ensuing loan project
3. Determine the feasibility of the proposed investments for priority infrastructure and systems improvements
4. Ensure that detailed design work supervised by DNSA is carried out to the required quality, and (v) identify appropriate project management arrangements to ensure that MOP and Estatal have adequate capacity to implement the project.
