Project Description

According to the Bank's website, tranche 3 of the project is aligned with the following impacts: (i) agriculture production improved and economic growth sustained in the North Central Province, Central Province, Northwestern Province and Eastern Province improved; and (ii) food security enhanced. Tranche 3 will have the following outcome: water conveyance systems and agricultural productivity in the project areas enhanced.

Tranche 3 is estimated to cost \$125.54 million (regular loan of \$93 million from ADB's ordinary capital resources, and government financing of \$32.54 million).



Early Warning System Project Analysis

Tranche 3 is categorized as A for environment and B for involuntary resettlement.

Tranche 3 will not involve areas owned and inhabited by Indigenous Peoples and will not affect Indigenous Peoples. Therefore, the tranche is categorized C in accordance with the ADB Safeguard Policy Statement.
