According to ADB website, the Subyai Wind Power Project entails the construction of a 90MW wind power plant in Subyai district, Chaiyaphum province. The Project will be implemented under a 5-year automatically-renewable Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) with the Electricity Generating Authority of Thailand (EGAT) under the Small Power Producers (SPP) program. The Project is an extension of the very small 7.5 MW Theppana Wind Power Project, which was financed by the ADB in 2013 to provide a financing structure that can be easily replicated for the much larger 90MW Subyai Wind Power Project.
